Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 03/24/00 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note was Prepared (Referred Unamended by the Health, Environment, Welfare, and Institutions Committee 03/28/00; Amended by the House Appropriations Committee 04/07/00; and Referred Unamended by the Senate Health, Environment, Welfare and Institutions Committee 04/19/00)

1. The *House Appropriations Committee* amendment provides \$157,846 General Fund for the implementation of the bill in FY 2000-01.

Amendments/Appropriation Status

In its present form, the bill contains a clause that appropriates \$157,846 General Fund and 2.0 FTE to the Department of Public Health and Environment for FY 2000-01. The funds are to be used to coordinate suicide prevention programs throughout the state. The General Fund appropriation is to be split evenly between the House (\$78,923) and Senate (\$78,923) set-aside funds. In addition, staff has prepared **J.003** which corrects a technical error in the appropriation clause.
