12 After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the
13 following:

15 **HB01-1273** be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to
16 the Committee on Appropriations with favorable
17 recommendation:

19 Amend printed bill, page 3, line 16, after the period, insert "THE HEALTH
20 BENEFIT PLAN SHALL ONLY BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR
21 BENEFITS THAT ARE MEDICALLY NECESSARY AND OTHERWISE COVERED
22 UNDER THE PLAN. SUCH COVERAGE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO COPAYMENT,
23 DEDUCTIBLE, AND POLICY MAXIMUMS AND LIMITATIONS. HEALTH BENEFIT
24 PLANS ISSUED BY AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PART 4 OF
25 THIS ARTICLE MAY PROVIDE THAT THE BENEFITS REQUIRED PURSUANT TO
26 THIS SECTION SHALL BE COVERED BENEFITS ONLY IF THE SERVICES ARE
27 RENDERED BY A PROVIDER WHO IS DESIGNATED BY AND AFFILIATED WITH
28 THE HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION.";

32 "SECTION 3. 26-4-302 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
33 amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH, and the said

42 OUTPATIENT SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 26-4-
43 103.

44 (b) IF THE REPORT SUBMITTED TO THE LEGISLATIVE AUDIT
45 COMMITTEE PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2) DOES
46 NOT SHOW COST NEUTRALITY TO THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM,
47 PARAGRAPH (u) OF SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION IS REPEALED."
