A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE**
102 **LOW-INCOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, AND MAKING AN**
103 **APPROPRIATION THEREFOR.**

Bill Summary

Authorizes the general assembly to appropriate a specified amount of moneys from the operational account of the severance tax trust fund to increase funding for the low-income energy assistance program.

Makes an appropriation.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 39-29-109 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
3 amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:

4 **39-29-109. Severance tax trust fund - created - administration**
5 **- use of moneys - repeal.** (1) (e) (I) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION
6 IN THIS SECTION TO THE CONTRARY, FOR THE STATE FISCAL YEAR
7 COMMENCING JULY 1, 2000, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY APPROPRIATE
8 AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TEN MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE
9 OPERATIONAL ACCOUNT OF THE SEVERANCE TAX TRUST FUND TO THE
10 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE PURPOSE OF INCREASING
11 AVAILABLE FUNDS UNDER THE LOW-INCOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE
12 PROGRAM.

13 (II) THIS PARAGRAPH (e) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2002.

14 **SECTION 2. Appropriation.** In addition to any other
15 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
16 operational account of the severance tax trust fund created in section
17 39-29-109, Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the
18 department of human services, self-sufficiency, special purpose welfare
19 programs for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, the sum of ten million
20 dollars (\$10,000,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the
21 implementation of this act.

22 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
23 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
24 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
