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**Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 02/22/01 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note was Prepared (Amended by the House Appropriations Committee 04/11/01, Referred Unamended by the Senate Judiciary Committee 04/25/01)**

The House Appropriations Committee amendment added an appropriations clause that reflects the costs of the bill as set forth in the Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note.

**Amendments/Appropriation Status**

Section 2-2-703, C.R.S., requires that all bills resulting in a net increase in periods of imprisonment be passed with five years of appropriations for prison bed construction and operating expenses.

The bill contains an appropriations clause that:

- Transfers \$69,467 General Fund to the Capital Construction Fund which will exempt this expenditure from the six percent Arveschoug-Bird limit in FY 2001-02;
- Transfers \$69,467 from the Capital Construction Fund to the Corrections Expansion Reserve Fund in FY 2001-02;
- Appropriates non-exempt operating costs of \$26,689 General Fund to the Department of Corrections for four years beginning in FY 2002-03.
