**EXECUTIVE ORDER
AMENDMENT**

Amending Executive Order D 011 01

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Office of the Governor of the State of Colorado, and in particular vested in the Governor pursuant to Article IV, Section 9 of the Colorado Constitution, and as provided for in Article V, Section 7, I, Bill Owens, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order amending Executive Order D 011 01 and designating additional subjects for consideration during the second special session of the Sixty-Third General Assembly.

Executive Order D 011 01 dated September 10, 2001, as amended by Executive Order D 013 01 is hereby amended with the addition and designation of the following call items to Section 2:

2. Proclamation

P. Concerning a pilot program to provide a group benefit insurance plan to state employees.

Q. Concerning funding reductions in capital projects.

INTRODUCTION OF RESOLUTION

1 The following resolution was read by title and laid over until later:

3 **HR01S2-1004** by Representative(s) Clapp--Concerning encouragement
4 of school district policies to prevent desecration of the
5 American flag in public schools.
6

7 WHEREAS, Only days after the tragic events of September 11,
8 2001, a student at Littleton High School chose to wear clothing to her
9 public school that depicted an American flag, desecrated by profanity;
10 and
11

12 WHEREAS, The picture of the desecrated flag had the effect of
13 inciting and provoking another student, leading to a disruptive verbal
14 altercation between the two students; and
15

16 WHEREAS, Desecrating the American flag is likely to incite and
17 provoke students, potentially causing disruption, verbal altercations, and
18 violence in our public schools; and
19

20 WHEREAS, Each school district board of education is currently
21 required by statute to adopt a safe school plan that will provide an
22 environment that is safe, conducive to the learning process, and free from
23 unnecessary disruption; and
24

25 WHEREAS, Each school district's safe school plan by statute must
26 include a conduct and discipline code that establishes general policies
27 regarding student conduct, safety, and welfare; a dress code policy that
28 defines and prohibits students from wearing apparel that is deemed
29 disruptive to the classroom environment or to the maintenance of a safe
30 and orderly school; and general policies and procedures for dealing with
31 students who cause a disruption in the classroom, on school grounds, in
32 school vehicles, or at school activities or sanctioned events; and
33

34 WHEREAS, Because the desecration of the American flag can
35 involve clothing, action, and words, and may or may not be clearly
36 addressed by any school district policy currently required by state statute;
37 now, therefore,
38

39 *Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Sixty-third*
40 *General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*
41

42 That, because desecration of the American flag is likely to incite
43 and provoke violence in our public schools, each school district board of
44 education is encouraged to develop a specific school district policy
45 concerning the desecration of the American flag in whatever form such
46 desecration occurs.
47

48 *Be It Further Resolved,* That a copy of this Resolution be sent to
49 each school district in the state of Colorado and to the Colorado
50 Department of Education, and that the copy be displayed in an
51 appropriate location in each facility or office.
