Education After consideration on the merits, the committee recommends that **SB02-052** be amended as follows and, as so amended be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation.

Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 2 and 3 and substitute the following:

"**SECTION 1.** 24-32-114 (1) (c) and (1) (d), Colorado Revised Statutes, are amended to read:";

after line 15, insert the following:

"(c) Up to ~~twenty~~ THIRTY percent of the moneys appropriated to

the department of local affairs from the waste tire recycling development cash fund may be expended to provide for partial reimbursement to processors and end users, up to a maximum of fifty dollars for each ton of raw Colorado waste tires that are processed or used. The purpose of such partial reimbursements shall be to assist new waste tire recycling technologies to become economically feasible and to thereby encourage the use of waste tires and reduce the storage of waste tires in Colorado."
