Resolution Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this resolution as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Amends the Colorado constitution, which requires the selection of county surveyors by election, to also allow the appointment of county surveyors as shall be provided by law.

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Sixty-third General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate concurring herein:

SECTION 1. At the next election at which such question may be submitted, there shall be submitted to the registered electors of the state of Colorado, for their approval or rejection, the following amendment to the constitution of the state of Colorado, to wit:

Section 8 of article XIV of the constitution of the state of Colorado, is amended to read:

Section 8. County officers - election - term - salary. There shall be elected in each county, at the same time at which members of the general assembly are elected, commencing in the year nineteen hundred and fifty-four, and every four years thereafter, one county clerk, who shall be ex officio recorder of deeds and clerk of the board of county commissioners; one sheriff; one coroner; one treasurer who shall be collector of taxes; one county superintendent of schools; one county surveyor one county assessor; and one county attorney who may be elected or appointed, as shall be provided by law; AND ONE OR MORE COUNTY SURVEYOR WHO MAY BE ELECTED OR APPOINTED, AS MAY BE PROVIDED BY LAW; and such officers shall be paid such salary or compensation, either from the fees, perquisites and emoluments of their respective offices, or from the general county fund, as may be provided by law. The term of office of all such officials shall be four years, and they shall take office on the second Tuesday in January next following their election, or at such other time as may be provided by law. The officers herein named elected at the general election in 1954 shall hold

1	their respective offices until the second Tuesday of January, 1959.
2	SECTION 2. Each elector voting at said election and desirous of
3	voting for or against said amendment shall cast a vote as provided by law
4	either "Yes" or "No" on the proposition: "AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 8
5	OF ARTICLE XIV OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO,
6	CONCERNING A REQUIREMENT FOR THE SELECTION OF COUNTY SURVEYORS
7	BY ELECTION, TO ALSO ALLOW THE APPOINTMENT OF COUNTY
8	SURVEYORS."
9	SECTION 3. The votes cast for the adoption or rejection of said
10	amendment shall be canvassed and the result determined in the manner
11	provided by law for the canvassing of votes for representatives in
12	Congress, and if a majority of the electors voting on the question shall
13	have voted "Yes", the said amendment shall become a part of the state
14	constitution.
