After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB02-1144 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 18, after "DATE", insert ", OR BOTH,".
- 2 Page 3, line 1, strike "THIS" and substitute "EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN
- 3 PARAGRAPH (c) OF THIS SUBSECTION (5), THIS";
- 4 line 6, strike "ON" and substitute "EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (c)
- 5 OF THIS SUBSECTION (5), ON";
- 6 after line 10, insert the following:
 - 7 "(c) ON AND AFTER JANUARY 1, 2005, THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY
 - 8 TO:
 - 9 (I) INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION; AND
 - 10 (II) PERSONS WHO EMPLOY NO MORE THAN TWENTY-FIVE
 - 11 EMPLOYEES OR WHO HAVE GENERATED NO MORE THAN FIVE MILLION
 - 12 DOLLARS ANNUALLY IN REVENUES FROM THE PERSON'S BUSINESS
 - 13 ACTIVITIES.";
- 14 strike lines 11 through 19 and substitute the following:

1 **"SECTION 2. Effective date.** This act shall take effect January
2 1, 2004, unless a referendum petition is filed during the ninety-day period
3 after final adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for
4 submitting a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the
5 state constitution. If such a referendum petition is filed against this act
6 or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act,
7 item, section, or part shall take effect on the specified date only if
8 approved by the people."
