**HB03-1314** be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

Amend printed bill, page 3, line 2, strike "AT" and substitute "WITH A REPRESENTATIVE OF ONE OR MORE EMPLOYEES AT";

after line 3, insert the following:

**"SECTION 2.** 22-32-109.4, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

**22-32-109.4. "Colorado School Collective Bargaining Agreement Sunshine Act" - board of education - specific duties.**

(4) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 24-6-402 (4) (e) (I), C.R.S., ANY MEETING OF A BOARD OF EDUCATION WITH A REPRESENTATIVE OF EMPLOYEES AT WHICH A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT IS DISCUSSED SHALL BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AND ANY NOTICE REQUIRED BY SECTION 24-6-402 (2) (c), C.R.S., SHALL BE GIVEN PRIOR TO THE MEETING."

Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

**SB03-067** be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

Amend reengrossed bill, page 5, strike lines 18 through 20 and substitute the following:

"NOT APPLY TO ANY MERGER OF PARCELS OF LAND THAT IS REQUESTED IN WRITING BY EACH OWNER OF AN EFFECTED PARCEL."

**SB03-086** be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation.
