AN ENTITY IN A RURAL AREA MAY BE EXEMPT FROM THIS REQUIREMENT IF THEY CAN DEMONSTRATE THAT THERE ARE NO PROVIDERS IN THE COMMUNITY TO PROVIDE ONE OR MORE OF THE COMPREHENSIVE PRIMARY CARE SERVICES."
