TITLE: CONCERNING THE RIGHT TO DISPLAY NATIONAL SYMBOLS.

Summary of Assessment

This bill allows the display of symbols of patriotism and specifies that this is a protected form of expression under the United States Constitution and the Colorado Constitution. Patriotic displays are allowed in the following locations:

- on a person;
- anywhere on personal or real property;
- place of employment; and
- any tax-supported property in the state.

This bill does not impact the operations of any state department. It has no fiscal impact. This bill takes effect 90 days after adjournment unless a referendum petition is filed (August 5, 2003).
