A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING PROVISIONS THAT GOVERN THE OPERATIONS OF

102 STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Modifies the role and mission of specified state-supported institutions of higher education.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 23-20-101, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended



1 to read:

2 23-20-101. University of Colorado - role and mission - all
3 campuses. (1) The role and mission of the several campuses of the
4 university of Colorado shall be as follows:

5 (a) The Boulder campus of the university of Colorado shall be a 6 comprehensive graduate research university with high SELECTIVE 7 admission standards. which offers THE BOULDER CAMPUS OF THE 8 UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO SHALL OFFER a comprehensive array of 9 undergraduate, MASTERS, AND DOCTORAL DEGREE programs. THE 10 BOULDER CAMPUS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO HAS EXCLUSIVE 11 AUTHORITY TO OFFER GRADUATE PROGRAMS IN LAW. The Colorado 12 commission on higher education, shall, after consultation with the board 13 of regents, further define the role and mission of the institution and 14 establish as great a distinction among the graduate offerings at the 15 Boulder campus of the university of Colorado, Colorado state university, 16 and the university of northern Colorado as is in its judgment 17 educationally, geographically, and economically appropriate IN 18 CONSULTATION WITH THE BOARD OF REGENTS, SHALL DESIGNATE THOSE 19 GRADUATE LEVEL PROGRAMS THAT ARE THE PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY OF 20 THE BOULDER CAMPUS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO. The board of 21 regents shall adhere to this further definition of role and mission. The 22 university has the responsibility to provide on a statewide basis, utilizing 23 when possible and appropriate the faculty and facilities of other 24 educational institutions, those graduate level programs. designated by the 25 commission as primarily its statewide responsibility. The commission 26 shall include in its funding recommendations a level of general fund 27 support for these programs.

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1 (b) The Denver campus of the university of Colorado shall be a2 AN URBAN comprehensive baccalaureate liberal arts and sciences 3 institution UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE RESEARCH UNIVERSITY with 4 high SELECTIVE admission standards. The Denver campus shall provide 5 selected professional programs and such graduate programs at the OFFER 6 BACCALAUREATE, masters, and A LIMITED NUMBER OF doctoral level 7 DEGREE PROGRAMS, as will EMPHASIZING THOSE THAT serve the needs of 8 the Denver metropolitan area. emphasizing those professional programs 9 not offered by other institutions of higher education. The DENVER 10 CAMPUS HAS STATEWIDE AUTHORITY TO OFFER GRADUATE PROGRAMS IN 11 PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION AND EXCLUSIVE AUTHORITY IN ARCHITECTURE 12 AND PLANNING.

13 (c) The Colorado Springs campus of the university of Colorado 14 shall be a comprehensive baccalaureate liberal arts and sciences 15 institution UNIVERSITY with selective admission standards. The Colorado 16 Springs campus shall provide selected professional programs and such 17 graduate programs as will serve the needs of the Colorado Springs 18 metropolitan area, emphasizing those professional programs not offered 19 by other institutions of higher education OFFER LIBERAL ARTS AND 20 SCIENCES, BUSINESS, ENGINEERING, HEALTH SCIENCES, AND TEACHER 21 PREPARATION UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS, AND A SELECTED 22 NUMBER OF MASTERS AND DOCTORAL DEGREE PROGRAMS.

(d) The HEALTH SCIENCES CENTER campus of the university of
 Colorado associated with the university of Colorado university hospital
 shall be a specialized professional institution offering SHALL OFFER
 SPECIALIZED baccalaureate, and graduate FIRST-PROFESSIONAL, MASTERS,
 AND DOCTORAL DEGREE programs in health-related disciplines and

professions. IT SHALL BE AFFILIATED WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF
 COLORADO HOSPITAL AND OTHER HEALTH CARE FACILITIES THAT OFFER
 SETTINGS FOR EDUCATION, CLINICAL PRACTICE, AND BASIC AND APPLIED
 RESEARCH. IT SHALL HAVE EXCLUSIVE AUTHORITY IN MEDICINE,
 DENTISTRY, PHARMACY, AND PHYSICAL THERAPY.

6 SECTION 2. 23-31-101, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
7 to read:

8 23-31-101. University established - role and mission. There is 9 hereby established a university at Fort Collins to be known as Colorado 10 state university. Colorado state university shall be a comprehensive 11 graduate research university with high SELECTIVE admission standards 12 offering a comprehensive array of undergraduate BACCALAUREATE, 13 MASTERS, AND DOCTORAL DEGREE programs consistent with the tradition 14 of land grant universities. COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY HAS EXCLUSIVE 15 AUTHORITY TO OFFER GRADUATE AND UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS IN 16 AGRICULTURE, FORESTRY, NATURAL RESOURCES, AND VETERINARY 17 MEDICINE. The Colorado commission on higher education, shall, after 18 consultation with the board of governors of the Colorado state university 19 system, further define the role and mission of the institution and establish 20 as great a distinction among the graduate offerings at the Boulder campus 21 of the university of Colorado, Colorado state university, and the 22 university of northern Colorado as is in its judgment educationally, 23 geographically, and economically appropriate. IN CONSULTATION WITH 24 THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM, 25 SHALL DESIGNATE THOSE GRADUATE LEVEL PROGRAMS THAT ARE THE 26 PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY OF COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY. The 27 governing board shall adhere to this further definition of role and mission.

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Colorado state university has the responsibility to provide on a statewide basis, utilizing when possible and appropriate the faculty and facilities of other educational institutions, those graduate level programs. designated by the commission as primarily its statewide responsibility. The commission shall include in its funding recommendations a level of general fund support for these programs.

7 SECTION 3. 23-40-101, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
8 to read:

9 **23-40-101.** University established - role and mission. There is 10 hereby established a university at Greeley, to be known as the university 11 of northern Colorado. The university of northern Colorado shall be a 12 general COMPREHENSIVE baccalaureate and specialized graduate research 13 university with selective admissions ADMISSION standards. The university 14 shall be the primary institution for undergraduate and graduate teacher 15 education DEGREE PROGRAMS FOR EDUCATIONAL PERSONNEL 16 PREPARATION in the state of Colorado. The university shall offer masters 17 and doctoral programs primarily in the field of education. The Colorado 18 commission on higher education shall, after consultation with the governing board, further define the role and mission of the institution and 19 20 establish as great a distinction among the graduate offerings at the 21 Boulder campus of the university of Colorado, Colorado state university, 22 and the university of northern Colorado as is in its judgment 23 educationally, geographically, and economically appropriate. The 24 governing board shall adhere to this further definition of role and mission. 25 The university of northern Colorado has the responsibility to provide 26 OFFER on a statewide basis, utilizing where possible and appropriate the 27 faculty and facilities of other educational institutions, those graduate level

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programs needed by professional educators and education administrators. 1 2 The commission shall include in its funding recommendations an 3 appropriate level of general fund support for those programs.

4 SECTION 4. 23-60-201, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read: 5

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23-60-201. State system of community colleges established -7 local district colleges - role and mission. There is hereby established a 8 state system of community and technical colleges which shall be under 9 the management and jurisdiction of the state board for community 10 colleges and occupational education. Each college shall be a two-year 11 institution The Mission of the community colleges shall be to 12 SERVE COLORADO RESIDENTS WHO RESIDE IN THEIR SERVICE AREAS BY 13 offering a broad range of general, personal, vocational, and technical 14 education programs. EACH COLLEGE SHALL BE A TWO-YEAR COLLEGE. 15 No college shall impose admission requirements upon any student. The 16 objects of the community and technical colleges shall be to provide 17 educational programs to fill the occupational needs of youth and adults 18 in technical and vocational fields, to provide two-year transfer 19 educational programs to qualify students for admission to the junior year 20 at other colleges and universities, BASIC SKILLS, WORKFORCE 21 DEVELOPMENT, and to provide a broad range of programs of personal and 22 vocational education for adults.

23 SECTION 5. 23-60-205, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended 24 to read:

25 **23-60-205.** Community and technical colleges. The state system 26 of community and technical colleges shall include: Arapahoe community 27 college, COLORADO NORTHWESTERN COMMUNITY COLLEGE, the

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1 community college of Aurora, the community college of Denver, Front 2 Range community college, Lamar community college, Morgan 3 community college, NORTHEASTERN JUNIOR COLLEGE, Otero junior 4 college, Pikes Peak community college, Pueblo community college, Red 5 Rocks community college, Trinidad state junior college, and Colorado 6 community college and occupational education system college. any local 7 district community college which joins the state system pursuant to part 8 2 of article 71 of this title; and any other such college created by the 9 general assembly. The state system of community and technical colleges 10 shall be governed by the state board for community colleges and 11 occupational education. Any college in the system may withdraw 12 pursuant to section 23-71-205.

13 SECTION 6. Article 72 of title 23, Colorado Revised Statutes,
14 is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read:

15 23-72-121.5. District colleges - role and mission. AIMS 16 COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND COLORADO MOUNTAIN COLLEGE SHALL BE 17 TWO-YEAR LOCAL DISTRICT COLLEGES WITH OPEN ADMISSION STANDARDS. 18 EACH COLLEGE'S MISSION SHALL BE TO SERVE COLORADO RESIDENTS IN 19 THE COLLEGE'S RESPECTIVE DESIGNATED SERVICE AREA BY OFFERING 20 ACADEMIC TWO-YEAR DEGREES, BASIC SKILLS, VOCATIONAL PROGRAMS, 21 WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT, AND A BROAD RANGE OF COURSES FOR 22 PROFESSIONAL AND PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT.

23 SECTION 7. Effective date. This act shall take effect July 1,
24 2003.

SECTION 8. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
