HB03-1024 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 3, strike lines 5 through 8.
- 2 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.
- 3 Page 7, strike lines 12 through 19.
- 4 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 5 Page 9, after line 27, insert the following:
 - 6 "SECTION 6. 24-33.5-415.7 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
 - 7 amended to read:
 - 8 **24-33.5-415.7. Amber alert program.** (2) For the purposes of
 - 9 this section, "abducted child" means a child:
 - 10 (a) Whose whereabouts are unknown;
 - 11 (b) (I) Whose domicile at the time he or she was reported missing
 - 12 was Colorado; OR

1 (II) ABOUT WHOM CREDIBLE INFORMATION IS RECEIVED FROM A
2 LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY LOCATED IN ANOTHER STATE THAT THE
3 ABDUCTED CHILD IS TRAVELING TO OR IN THE STATE OF COLORADO;

4 (c) Whose age at the time he or she was first reported missing was
5 seventeen years of age or younger; and

6 (d) Whose disappearance poses a credible threat as determined by
7 local law enforcement to the safety and health of the child.".

8 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
