Be it enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

Article XVIII of the constitution of the state of Colorado is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read:

Section 15: Protection of property owner's right to workmanlike construction. NO LAW SHALL LIMIT OR IMPAIR A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY OWNER'S RIGHT TO RECOVER DAMAGES, OTHER THAN PUNITIVE DAMAGES, CAUSED BY THE FAILURE TO CONSTRUCT AN IMPROVEMENT TO REAL PROPERTY IN A GOOD AND WORKMANLIKE MANNER, EXCEPT THAT STATUTES OF LIMITATIONS AND REPOSE SHALL BE PERMITTED. CONSTRUCTION IN A "GOOD AND WORKMANLIKE MANNER" SHALL INCLUDE, WITHOUT LIMITATION, CONSTRUCTION SO THAT THE IMPROVEMENT TO REAL PROPERTY IS SUITABLE FOR ITS INTENDED PURPOSES. THIS SECTION SHALL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.
