

Legal age of drinking in Colorado and driving will be as follows.

The legal age for drinking will be as follows. 14 for wine, 16 for 3.2 beer and 18 for all other alcoholic drinks. Schools and other events may limit drinking, as they desire.

Students in the front Range of Larimer, Weld, Denver Boulder, Adams, Douglas Arapahoe, Jefferson, El Paso and Pueblo counties will not allow students to drive to high schools or drive during the week days during school sessions. Mesa, Pitkin, Eagle, and La Plata counties will also follow these laws. Driving in the mountains, and bad weather will also be prohibited. Bad weather will have had to be an issue when the student started the trip and not a sudden change of weather in the mountains.
