

**Proposed Initiative Measure 2003 - 2004, #72 74
Concerning the Colorado Student Assessment Program**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Colorado

Section 1. Repeal.

Part 4 of Article 7 of Title 22, Colorado Revised Statutes and Part 3 of Article 30.5 of Title 22, are repealed.

Section 2. Repeal.

Section 22-7-504 of Colorado Revised Statutes which refers to state standards as set forth in Part 4 of Article 7 of Title 22 is repealed.

Section 3. Repeal.

Section 22-7-603.5, and 22-7-603.7 which mandate longitudinal analyses and academic growth of each student based on the Colorado Student Assessment Program results are repealed.

Section 22-7-604 of Colorado Revised Statutes which calculates a schools' academic performance and improvement ratings is repealed.

Section 22-7-605 of Colorado Revised Statutes which establishes the format of School accountability reports is repealed.

Section 22-7-609, which establishes School improvement plans, and Section 22-7-610, which contemplates a system of awards based on the results of the Colorado Student Assessment Program are repealed.

Section 22-7-611 of Colorado Revised Statutes which uses results from the Colorado Student Assessment Program as criteria for **Closing the achievement gap program** is repealed.

Section 4.

The Revisor of Statutes is hereby directed to prepare conforming amendments repealing all references to the statutes repealed pursuant to Sections 1-3 above, including but not limited to references to Section 22-7-409 found in Section 22-7-604.5
