SUBJECT:

Fiscal Assessment of Proposed Amendment HB1001_L.003.

This memorandum is an assessment of the fiscal impact of the attached proposed amendment to **HB08-1001**. This fiscal assessment is for the impact of the bill with inclusion of this amendment <u>only</u>. Any other added amendment could influence the fiscal impact.

Summary of Proposed Amendment

This amendment modifies the funding source provided in the bill for the Bioscience Discover Evaluation Grant Program, and makes clarifications regarding eligibility of grant recipients. Specifically, the amendment:

- appropriates \$3.5 million in General Fund moneys to the Bioscience Discovery Evaluation Cash Fund in FY 2007-08 for implementation of the program, beginning in FY 2008-09;
- specifies that beginning in FY 2008-09, of moneys in the Limited Gaming Fund
 that would have been transferred to the General Fund, \$3.5 million will be
 transferred annually to the Bioscience Discovery Evaluation Cash Fund for the
 next 4 fiscal years through FY 20011-12; and
- specifies that, to be eligible for grant moneys, early-stage bioscience companies must have a licenced technology from a Colorado research institution of higher education.

Fiscal Impact of Amendment

In FY 2007-08, of moneys in the Limited Gaming Fund that would have been transferred to the General Fund, HB08-1001 as introduced transferred \$3.5 million to the Bioscience Discovery Evaluation Cash Fund. This amendment eliminates this transfer, and instead appropriates a like amount of General Fund to this fund. In addition, the

amendment specifies that \$3.5 million will be annually transferred from the General Fund portion of the Limited Gaming Fund to the Bioscience Discovery Evaluation Cash Fund from FY 2008-09 through FY 2011-12 for expenditure in the following fiscal year.

Bill's Revised Fiscal Impact with Amendment

Thus, if this amendment is adopted, the bill will be assessed as having a state fiscal impact with a General Fund appropriation of \$3.5 million in FY 2007-08, and the transfer of a like amount from the General Fund portion of the Limited Gaming Fund to the Bioscience Discovery Evaluation Cash Fund in each of the following 4 fiscal years.
