A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING ADJUSTING FEES CHARGED BY THE OFFICE OF THE STATE
102 REGISTRAR TO SUPPORT THE COLORADO RESPONDS TO
103 CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS PROGRAM.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Allows the office of the state registrar to adjust its fees to reflect the direct and indirect costs necessary to maintain and operate the Colorado responds to children with special needs program.

Shading denotes HOUSE amendment. Double underlining denotes SENATE amendment.
Capital letters indicate new material to be added to existing statute.
Dashes through the words indicate deletions from existing statute.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 25-2-121 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
3 amended to read:

4 **25-2-121. Fee adjustments - vital statistics records cash fund**
5 **created.** (2) (a) The office of the state registrar shall propose, as part of
6 its annual budget request, an adjustment in the amount of each fee ~~which~~
7 THAT the office of the state registrar is authorized by law to collect. The
8 budget request and the adjusted fees for the office of the state registrar
9 shall reflect ITS direct and indirect costs AND THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT
10 COSTS NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN AND OPERATE THE COLORADO RESPONDS
11 TO CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS PROGRAM.

12 (b) (I) Based upon the appropriation made and subject to the
13 approval of the executive director of the department of public health and
14 environment, the office of the state registrar shall adjust its fees so that
15 the revenue generated from said fees approximates its direct and indirect
16 costs AND THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN AND
17 OPERATE THE COLORADO RESPONDS TO CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS
18 PROGRAM. Such fees shall remain in effect for the fiscal year for which
19 the budget request applies. All fees collected by the office of the state
20 registrar shall be transmitted to the state treasurer, who shall credit the
21 same to the vital statistics records cash fund, which fund is hereby
22 created. All moneys credited to the vital statistics records cash fund and
23 all interest earned thereon shall be subject to appropriation by the general
24 assembly to be used as provided in this section and shall not be deposited
25 in or transferred to the general fund of this state or any other fund.

26 (II) For those services required by this article AND THOSE
27 SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE COLORADO RESPONDS TO CHILDREN WITH

1 SPECIAL NEEDS PROGRAM, each office designated or established pursuant
2 to section 25-2-103 shall charge fees as specified by the state registrar.
3 Such an office shall retain all such fees for the purpose of paying the
4 direct and indirect costs of compliance with the provisions of this article
5 AND THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN AND
6 OPERATE THE COLORADO RESPONDS TO CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS
7 PROGRAM.

8 (c) Beginning July 1, 1985, and each July 1 thereafter, whenever
9 moneys appropriated to the office of the state registrar for its activities for
10 the prior fiscal year are unexpended, said moneys shall be made a part of
11 the appropriation to the office of the state registrar for the next fiscal year,
12 and such amount shall not be raised from fees collected by the office of
13 the state registrar. If a supplemental appropriation is made to the office
14 of the state registrar for its activities AND THE SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE
15 COLORADO RESPONDS TO CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS PROGRAM, the
16 fees of the office of the state registrar, when adjusted for the fiscal year
17 ~~next~~ following that in which the supplemental appropriation was made,
18 shall be adjusted by an additional amount ~~which~~ THAT is sufficient to
19 compensate for ~~such~~ THE supplemental appropriation. Moneys
20 appropriated to the office of the state registrar in the annual general
21 appropriation act shall be designated as cash funds and shall not exceed
22 the amount anticipated to be raised from fees collected by the office of
23 the state registrar.

24 (d) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "COLORADO RESPONDS TO
25 CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS PROGRAM" MEANS THE PROGRAM
26 ESTABLISHED WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND
27 ENVIRONMENT UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF SECTION 25-1.5-105.

1 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
2 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
3 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
