Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB08-219 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the Health and Human Services Committee Report, dated April
2 29, 2008, page 19, strike lines 9 through 38 and insert the following:

3 **"SECTION 5. Appropriation.** (1) In addition to any other
4 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
5 division of registrations cash fund created in section 24-34-105 (2) (b) (I),
6 Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department
7 of regulatory agencies, for allocation to the executive director's office, for
8 legal services, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008, the sum of
9 eighteen thousand eight dollars (\$18,008), or so much thereof as may be
10 necessary, for the implementation of this act.

11 (2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
12 appropriated, out of any moneys in the division of registrations cash fund
13 created in section 24-34-105 (2) (b) (I), Colorado Revised Statutes, not
14 otherwise appropriated, to the department of regulatory agencies, for
15 allocation to the division of registrations, for regulation of massage
16 therapists, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008, the sum of two
17 hundred fifty-four thousand five hundred eighty-three dollars (\$254,583)
18 and 3.5 FTE, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the
19 implementation of this act.

20 (3) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
21 appropriated to the department of regulatory agencies, for allocation to
22 the division of registrations, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008, the
23 sum of two hundred forty-three thousand seven hundred sixty-eight

1 dollars (\$243,768), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for pass
2 through to the department of public safety, to perform criminal history
3 background checks for massage therapists related to the implementation
4 of this act. Said sum shall be from application processing fees collected
5 by the division of registrations.

6 (4) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
7 appropriated to the department of law, for the fiscal year beginning July
8 1, 2008, the sum of eighteen thousand eight dollars (\$18,008) and 0.2
9 FTE, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the provision of legal
10 services to the department of regulatory agencies related to the
11 implementation of this act. Said sum shall be from reappropriated funds
12 received from the executive director's office out of the appropriation
13 made in subsection (1) of this section.

14 (5) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
15 appropriated, to the department of public safety, for allocation to the
16 Colorado bureau of investigation, for processing of fingerprint-based
17 criminal history background checks for massage therapists, for the fiscal
18 year beginning July 1, 2008, the sum of one hundred thirty-one thousand
19 six hundred forty-three dollars (\$131,643) and 1.2 FTE, or so much
20 thereof as may be necessary, for the implementation of this act. Said sum
21 shall be from reappropriated funds received from the department of
22 regulatory agencies, division of registrations, out of the appropriation
23 made in subsection (3) of this section.

24 (6) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
25 appropriated to the department of public safety, for the fiscal year
26 beginning July 1, 2008, the sum of one hundred twelve thousand one
27 hundred twenty-five dollars (\$112,125), or so much thereof as may be
28 necessary, for pass through to the federal bureau of investigation for
29 fingerprint-based national criminal history background checks for
30 massage therapists related to the implementation of this act. Said sum
31 shall be from reappropriated funds received from the department of
32 regulatory agencies, division of registrations, out of the appropriation
33 made in subsection (3) of this section.";
