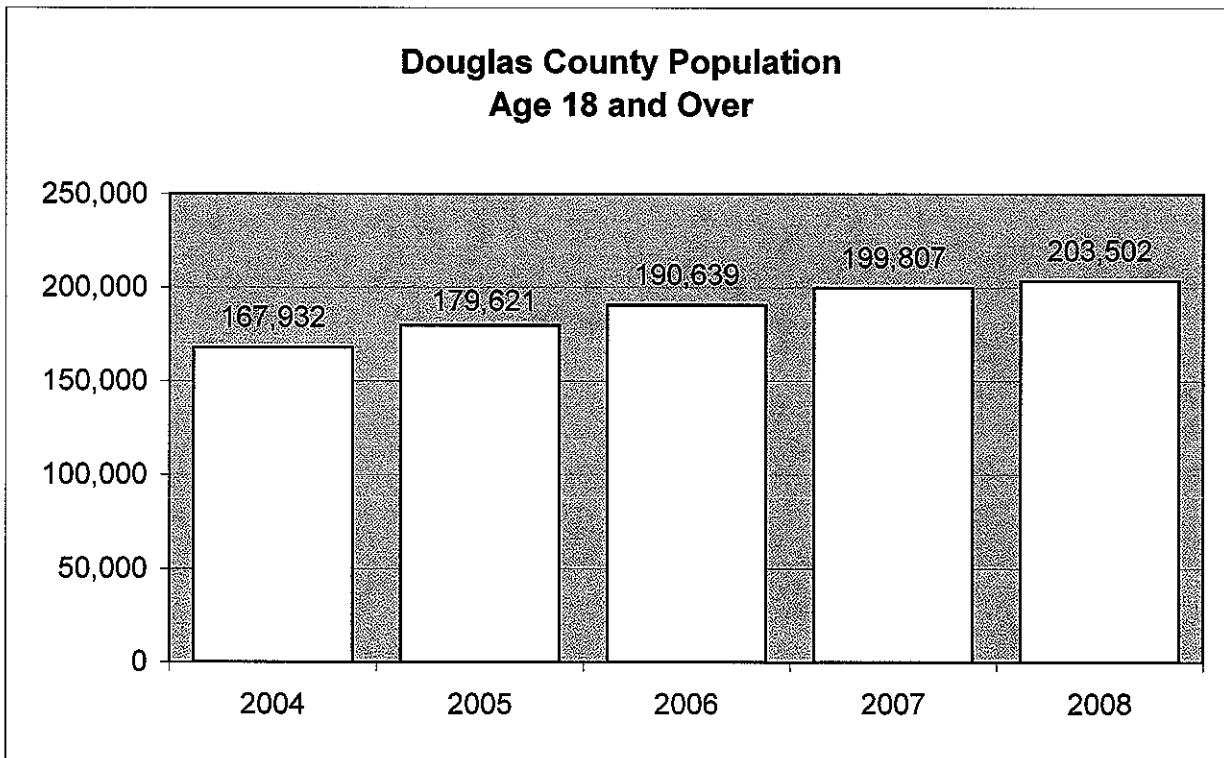

Douglas County Population

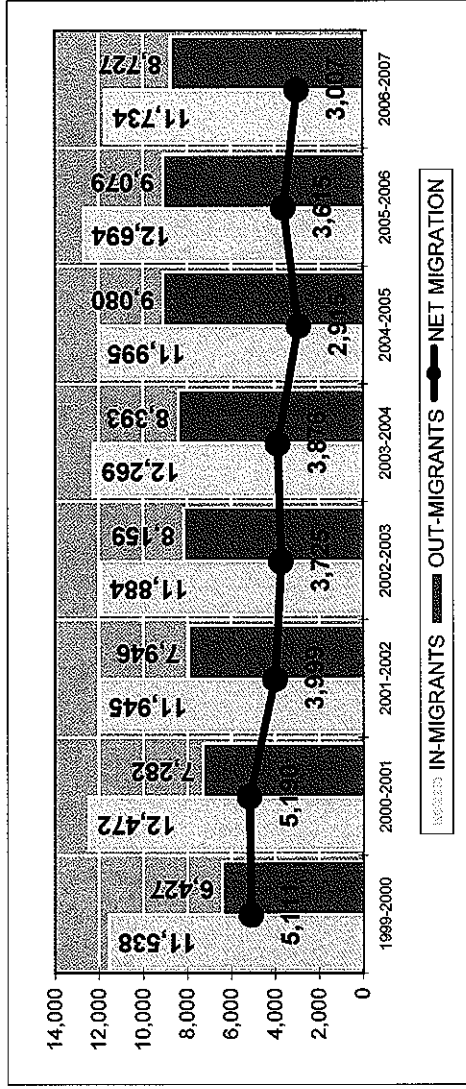
Approximately 71% of the Douglas County Population is Age 18 and Over.

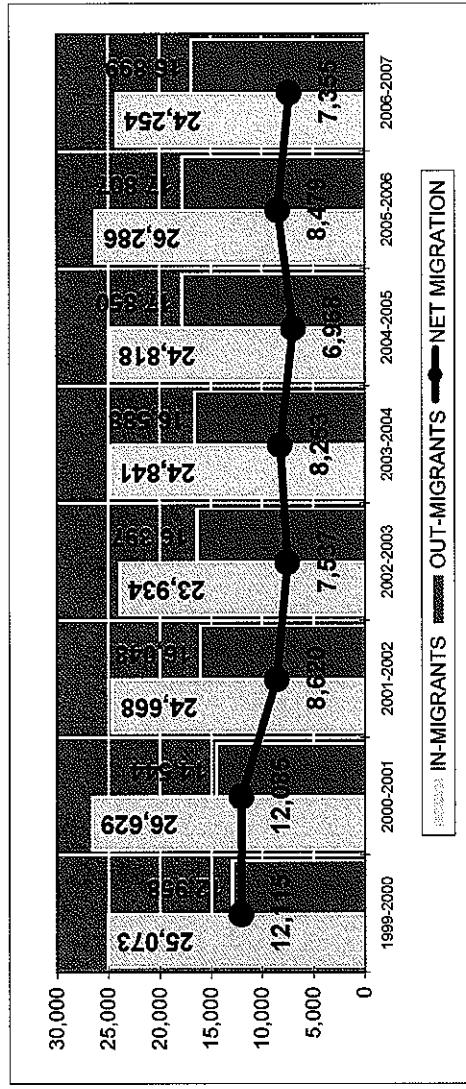


MIGRATION - NUMBER OF TAX RETURNS AND EXEMPTIONS
