After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB09-1065 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 3, line 24, strike "**Pilot Program**" and
- 2 substitute "**System**".
- 3 Page 4, line 7, strike "SECTION 22-68.5-104." and substitute "SECTION
- 4 22-68.5-103.";
- 5 line 10, after "PROGRAM", insert "AND SYSTEM";
- 6 strike lines 11 and 12 and substitute the following:
 - 7 "(6) "PILOT PROGRAM" MEANS THE DEVELOPMENTAL PHASES OF
 - 8 THE EDUCATOR IDENTIFIER SYSTEM CREATED IN SECTION 22-68.5-102.
 - 9 THIS DEFINITION SHALL BE REPEALED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AFTER
 - 10 THE STATE BOARD CERTIFIES IN WRITING THAT THE SYSTEM IS FULLY
 - 11 OPERATIONAL AND AVAILABLE TO EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE STATE
 - 12 PURSUANT TO THE MINIMUM PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.";
- 13 after line 19, insert the following:
 - 14 "(9) "SYSTEM" MEANS THE EDUCATOR IDENTIFIER SYSTEM
 - 15 CREATED AND DESCRIBED IN SECTION 22-68.5-102.".
- 16 Renumber the succeeding subsections accordingly.
- 17 Page 5, line 9, after "**identifier**", insert "**system and**";



- 1 line 10, strike "(1) (a)" and substitute "(1)";
- 2 line 11, after "IDENTIFIER", insert "SYSTEM AND";
- 3 line 12, strike "EDUCATORS EMPLOYED IN A LOCAL" and substitute
- 4 "EDUCATORS. THE SYSTEM";
- 5 strike line 13;
- 6 line 14, strike "PROGRAM";
- 7 strike lines 17 through 27.
- 8 Page 6, strike lines 1 and 2;
- 9 line 4, strike "PILOT PROGRAM." and substitute "SYSTEM.";
- 10 line 11, strike "PILOT PROGRAM" and substitute "SYSTEM";
- 11 line 13, strike "PURPOSES:" and substitute "USES:";
- 12 line 22, strike "PILOT PROGRAM" and substitute "SYSTEM";
- 13 strike lines 25 through 27 and substitute the following:
 - 14 (a) THE DATA OBTAINED FROM THE SYSTEM MAY NOT BE USED BY
 - 15 THE STATE TO NEGATIVELY SANCTION INDIVIDUAL TEACHERS. LOCAL
 - 16 SCHOOL DISTRICTS MAY NOT RELY SOLELY ON DATA OBTAINED FROM
 - 17 STUDENT PERFORMANCE DATA OBTAINED FROM THE SYSTEM TO EVALUATE
 - 18 AND SANCTION INDIVIDUAL TEACHERS, AND LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS
 - 19 MAY NOT USE DATA OBTAINED FROM THE SYSTEM IN AN ARBITRARY AND
 - 20 CAPRICIOUS MANNER TO NEGATIVELY SANCTION INDIVIDUAL TEACHERS.
 - 21 (b) THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER
 - 22 EDUCATION SHALL NOT USE THE DATA OBTAINED FROM THE SYSTEM TO
 - 23 SANCTION ANY SCHOOL DISTRICT OR EDUCATOR PREPARATION OR
 - 24 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM; HOWEVER, SAID DEPARTMENTS
 - 25 MAY PROVIDE THESE DATA TO DISTRICTS AND PROGRAMS TO BE USED FOR
 - 26 PROGRAM IMPROVEMENT AND MAY REQUIRE THAT THESE DATA BE
 - 27 CONSIDERED AND RESPONDED TO AS PART OF THE ACCREDITATION
 - 28 PROCESS ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO PART 2 OF ARTICLE 11 OF THIS TITLE



1 AND THE APPROVAL PROCESS ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SECTION
2 23-1-121, C.R.S. THE DEPARTMENT AND DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER
3 EDUCATION, IN CONSULTATION WITH INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION,
4 SHALL SET UP PROTOCOLS FOR RELEASING SYSTEM DATA OF GRADUATES
5 TO THEIR RESPECTIVE TEACHER PREPARATION PROGRAMS FOR THE
6 PURPOSE OF SELF-EVALUATION. PROTOCOLS SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL
7 FEDERAL LAWS. THE DEPARTMENT AND DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER
8 EDUCATION MAY ALSO USE THESE DATA TO PRELIMINARILY IDENTIFY
9 PRACTICES THAT MAY SHOW PROMISE, IF THE PRACTICES ARE VERIFIED BY
10 ADDITIONAL EVIDENCE."

11 Page 7, strike lines 1 through 9;

12 line 10, strike "PILOT PROGRAM" and substitute "SYSTEM";

13 line 16, strike "PILOT PROGRAM" and substitute "SYSTEM";

14 strike lines 17 and 18 and substitute the following:

15 "(e) THE SYSTEM SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL STATE AND FEDERAL
16 PRIVACY LAWS IN ORDER TO ENSURE THE CONFIDENTIALITY AND
17 APPROPRIATE USES OF INFORMATION FOUND IN THE SYSTEM.";

18 after line 23, insert the following:

19 "(5) THE SYSTEM SHALL MAKE POSSIBLE, AT A MINIMUM, THE
20 FOLLOWING:

21 (a) THE DATA OBTAINED FROM THE SYSTEM MAY BE USED BY THE
22 STATE TO REPORT THE EXTENT TO WHICH ALL STUDENTS HAVE ACCESS TO
23 QUALIFIED AND EFFECTIVE TEACHERS, INCLUDING THE NUMBER AND
24 PERCENT OF TEACHERS IN THE HIGHEST POVERTY AND LOWEST POVERTY
25 SCHOOLS IN THE STATE WHO ARE HIGHLY QUALIFIED.

26 (b) LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS MAY USE THE DATA OBTAINED FROM
27 THE SYSTEM, IN COMBINATION WITH ALL OTHER DATA AT THEIR DISPOSAL
28 THAT THEY CHOOSE TO APPLY TO THIS TASK, TO EVALUATE TEACHERS AND
29 PRINCIPALS AND TO DESIGNATE THE PERFORMANCE LEVEL OF TEACHERS.
30 THE DESIGNATION MAY INCLUDE EVIDENCE OF A TEACHER'S IMPACT ON
31 STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT OUTCOMES AND A DESIGNATION OF THE
32 PERFORMANCE LEVEL OF TEACHERS THAT ADDRESSES A RANGE OF



1 QUALITY LEVELS.

2 (c) THE STATE SHALL USE THE SYSTEM TO PROVIDE TIMELY DATA
3 TO LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS ON THE PERFORMANCE OF STUDENTS AND
4 ESTIMATES OF INDIVIDUAL TEACHER IMPACT ON STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT
5 IN A MANNER THAT INFORMS INSTRUCTION AND INCLUDES APPROPRIATE
6 BENCHMARKS."

7 Renumber succeeding subsection accordingly.

8 Page 8, strike lines 3 through 18.

9 Renumber succeeding C.R.S. sections accordingly.

10 Page 1, line 103, strike "PILOT PROGRAM," and substitute "SYSTEM,".

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
