14 15 16 17 18 19 20	(III) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 31, 2010, EACH COLORADO PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL COLLABORATE WITH THE DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH A STATEWIDE TEMPLATE REGARDING THE TRANSFER OF CREDITS TO AN INSTITUTION FROM ANOTHER INSTITUTION, WHICH STATEWIDE TEMPLATE SHALL INCLUDE EACH TRANSFER GUIDE OF EACH INSTITUTION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL THEREAFTER MAINTAIN THE STATEWIDE TEMPLATE AND MAKE THE TEMPLATE AVAILABLE TO THE

- 5 (IV) ON OR BEFORE JUNE 1, 2010, AND THEREAFTER, THE 6 DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC ON THE 7 DEPARTMENT'S WEB SITE:
- 8 (A) EACH TRANSFER GUIDE OF EACH COLORADO PUBLIC 9 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION; AND
- 10 (B) ANY ARTICULATION AGREEMENT THAT HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED
 11 BY THE COMMISSION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL THEREAFTER MAKE
 12 AVAILABLE ON ITS WEB SITE ANY ARTICULATION AGREEMENT WITHIN

- 20 (A) "ARTICULATION AGREEMENT" MEANS A WRITTEN AGREEMENT 21 ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION THAT FORMALIZES A PLAN FOR A 22 STUDENT TO COMPLETE A SIXTY-CREDIT CURRICULUM AND ENSURES THE 23 STUDENT THAT, IF HE OR SHE COMPLETES THE CURRICULUM, HE OR SHE 24 SHALL BE REQUIRED TO TAKE NO MORE THAN SIXTY ADDITIONAL CREDITS 25 AT ANY COLORADO PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO 26 COMPLETE THE CURRICULAR REQUIREMENTS FOR A PARTICULAR 27 ONE-HUNDRED-TWENTY-HOUR BACCALAUREATE DEGREE.
- 28 (B) "TRANSFER GUIDE" MEANS A WRITTEN AGREEMENT BETWEEN
 29 TWO OR MORE COLORADO PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION
 30 CONCERNING ADMISSION CRITERIA AND TRANSFERABILITY OF CREDITS FOR
 31 A SPECIFIC DEGREE PROGRAM.".
