## SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE REPORT

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB09-289 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 2, strike "24-32-114 (1) (a), (1) (b) (I),
- 2 and" and substitute "The introductory portion to 24-32-114 (1) and
- 3 24-32-114";
- 4 line 14, strike everything before "shall" and substitute "including 0.5
- 5 full-time equivalent employees (FTE);";
- 6 strike line 16.
- 7 Page 3, strike lines 1 through 26.
- 8 Page 4, strike lines 23 through 27 and substitute the following:
- 9 "weighing more than fifteen thousand pounds; except that no fee shall be
- 10 collected for tires that are recapped or otherwise reprocessed for use. The
- 11 ~~fee authorized by this section shall be collected only at such time as the~~
- 12 ~~owner of the tire delivers or transfers the waste tire to a retailer of new~~
- 13 ~~tires for disposal and shall be stated and shown as a separate and distinct".~~
- 14 Page 5, strike line 1 and substitute the following:
- 15 ~~"item on the statement~~ THE RECEIPT from the retailer to the customer FOR
- 16 EVERY NEW MOTOR VEHICLE TIRE SOLD IN COLORADO SHALL CONTAIN THE
- 17 FOLLOWING STATEMENT IN NO LESS THAN 15-POINT, BOLD-FACED TYPE:
- 18 "SECTION 25-17-202, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, REQUIRES
- 19 RETAILERS TO COLLECT A \$1.50 WASTE TIRE RECYCLING DEVELOPMENT



1 FEE ON THE SALE OF EACH NEW MOTOR VEHICLE TIRE."

2 Page 6, strike lines 1 through 8 and substitute the following:

3 "THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SHALL NOTIFY RETAILERS OF NEW MOTOR  
4 VEHICLE TIRES CONCERNING THE NEW REQUIREMENTS IN THIS SECTION  
5 ENACTED BY SENATE BILL 09-289, ENACTED IN 2009."

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
