After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB09-289 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 2 through 16.
- 2 Strike page 3.
- 3 Page 4, strike lines 1 through 11.
- 4 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 5 Page 4, line 13, strike "(b)" and substitute "(b), (2) (a),";
- 6 strike lines 23 through 27 and substitute the following:
- 7 "weighing more than fifteen thousand pounds; except that no fee shall be
- 8 collected for tires that are recapped or otherwise reprocessed for use. The
- 9 fee authorized by this section shall be collected only at such time as the
- 10 owner of the tire delivers or transfers the waste tire to a retailer of new
- tires for disposal and shall be stated and shown as a separate and distinct".
- 12 Page 5, strike line 1 and substitute the following:
- 13 "item on the statement THE RECEIPT from the retailer to the customer FOR
- 14 EVERY NEW MOTOR VEHICLE TIRE SOLD IN COLORADO SHALL CONTAIN THE
- 15 FOLLOWING STATEMENT IN NO LESS THAN FIFTEEN-POINT, BOLD-FACED
- 16 TYPE: "SECTION 25-17-202, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, REQUIRES
- 17 RETAILERS TO COLLECT A \$1.50 WASTE TIRE RECYCLING DEVELOPMENT
- 18 FEE ON THE SALE OF EACH NEW MOTOR VEHICLE TIRE.";



- 1 after line 25 insert the following:
- 2 "(2) (a) The Retailers of new MOTOR VEHICLE tires or a retailer of
- 3 motor vehicles that accepts exchanged property as described in section
- 4 39-26-102 (7) (a) (II), C.R.S., shall collect the fee.";
- 5 Page 6, strike lines 1 through 8 and substitute the following:
- 6 "THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SHALL NOTIFY RETAILERS OF NEW MOTOR
- 7 VEHICLE TIRES CONCERNING THE NEW REQUIREMENTS IN THIS SECTION
- 8 ENACTED BY SENATE BILL 09-289, ENACTED IN 2009.";
- 9 line 13, after "plan", insert "- definition";
- strike lines 23 through 27.
- 11 Page 7, strike lines 1 through 17 and substitute the following:
- 12 "(5) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "MONOFILL TIRE LANDFILL"
- 13 MEANS A "WASTE TIRE MONOFILL" AS DEFINED IN SECTION 30-20-1001.
- 14 **SECTION 4.** 25-17-204 (3) (a) (II), Colorado Revised Statutes,
- 15 is amended to read:
- 16 **25-17-204.** Waste tire haulers registration rules violations.
- 17 (3) The solid and hazardous waste commission shall promulgate rules to
- 18 implement this section, including:
- 19 (a) Requirements that persons who transport waste tires for

- 21 (II) Register with the department of public health and environment
- 22 AND ANNUALLY PROVIDE A COPY OF THE CURRENTLY VALID REGISTRATION

- SECTION 5. 30-20-1006 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
- amended to read:
- 27 30-20-1006. Limitations on the disposal of tires. (2) (a) A

- 1 person shall dispose of waste tires by delivery to a retailer or wholesaler
- 2 engaging in waste tire collection or recycling, to a waste tire monofill, or
- 3 to a collection or recycling facility operating under the laws of this state
- 4 or under rules promulgated by the United States environmental protection
- 5 agency.
- 6 (b) A PERSON, INCLUDING A RETAILER, WHOLESALER, AND A
 7 COLLECTION OR RECYCLING FACILITY, SHALL ARRANGE FOR THE
 8 COMMERCIAL HAULING OF WASTE TIRES ONLY WITH A HAULER WHO IS
 9 CURRENTLY REGISTERED PURSUANT TO SECTION 25-17-204, C.R.S.
- SECTION 6. 30-20-1007, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:
- 30-20-1007. Waste tires collection for recycling. A retailer selling replacement tires in the state may SHALL accept from customers, at the point of transfer, waste tires of the same general type and in a quantity at least equal to the number of new tires purchased. if offered by customers:".
