**Description:**

The Read-to-Achieve Board consists of 11 members, no more than six of whom are from the same political party, as follows:

- The Commissioner of Education;
- One member of the State Board of Education selected by the State Board of Education;
- One member of the Senate appointed by the President;
- One member of the House appointed by the Speaker;
- Seven members appointed by the Governor, with the consent of the Senate, as follows:
  - 2 kindergarten, second-, or third-grade elementary school teachers, one of whom works in a rural school district;
  - 1 elementary school principal;
  - 1 member with knowledge of and experience in public education in elementary grades;
  - 1 member with knowledge of the best practices in reading and reading instruction; and
  - 2 member who, at the time of appointment, are parents of a children enrolled in a public school.

The appointed members of the Read-to-Achieve Board shall serve terms of three years. No member appointed by the Governor shall serve more than two consecutive three-year terms. Whenever a vacancy exists, the Governor, President, or Speaker shall appoint a member for the remaining portion of the unexpired term created by the vacancy. An appointing authority may remove any board member for cause, including the failure of the board member to attend three consecutive meetings or at least 3/4 of the meetings of the board in a calendar year.
