10	(2) A temporary license issued pursuant to SUBSECTION (1) OF this

13	committee. In no event, however, shall such a license remain in effect
14	after the period certified by the committee pursuant to paragraph (b) of
15	subsection (1) of this section, unless the board has granted an extension.
16	The board shall not grant an extension in excess of ninety days.
17	(3) A temporary licensee ISSUED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1) OF
18	THIS SECTION shall provide chiropractic services only to athletes or team
19	personnel who are registered to train at the olympic training center or
20	compete in an event sanctioned by the United States olympic committee.".
