

have access to affordable prescriptions. Many low-income Maine people spend over 50% of their monthly income on prescription drugs. The Maine Rx Plus Benefit was created to give Maine residents access to affordable prescription drugs.

Who qualifies?

Maine Rx Plus will be available to most Maine residents without prescription drug coverage. This means a family of four with a monthly income lower than \$6,023 will be able to qualify.

How does Maine Rx Plus work?

Maine Rx Plus gives the State authority to serve as pharmaceutical benefit manager for those citizens without prescription drug insurance, and to negotiate lower prices directly from pharmaceutical manufacturers.

Discounts will be received by the State in the form of rebates from the manufacturers. Rebates will then be distributed to pharmacies that dispense discounted prescriptions to Maine Rx Plus participants.

Maine Rx Plus card holders will present their card at participating Maine pharmacies to receive discounts on new or refilled prescriptions.
