

A search was performed for the records of purported notaries James Austen, Janet Brown, Julia Furrer, Sam Hughes, Jared Schmidt, and Jennifer Westrob.

Our records indicate that four of the five notaries researched including James Austen, Julia Furrer, Sam Hughes, Jared Schmidt, and Jennifer Westrob have never been commissioned notaries in the State of Colorado.
