Senate Resolution B - Adopt a Senate Rule to provide for the line of succession in the event of the death, resignation, disability, or absence from the state of the Secretary of the Senate.	Not introduced	Does LEERC committee want to introduce this rule change in the 2010 session?
House Resolution C - Adopt a House rule to provide for the line of succession in the event of the death, resignation, disability, or absence from the state of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives.	Adopted as House Rule 43 (n) HR 09-1005	No action needed
House Joint Resolution D - Adopt a Joint Rule for the House and the Senate that provides rules of procedures for both houses during a declared disaster emergency where the governor issues an executive order that declares a state of emergency caused by a public health emergency. This rule would apply to either a regular session or a special session.	Adopted as Jt Rule 44 SJR 09-004	No action needed
Legislative Vacancies - Committee recommended that the Executive Committee consider legislation to address legislative vacancies.	Not discussed by Executive Committee.	Does LEERC Committee want to suggest this again to Executive Committee or introduce a bill to do this?
