A New Fiscal Constitution

- Preserve and strengthen tax and expenditure limits
 - Restore TABOR provisions
- Restore caps on property taxes
- Revisit tax rebate provisions
- government services voluntarily chosen by Limit user fees to cover the cost of citizens
- Require a supermajority vote of the legislature to propose new taxes

- Eliminate the structural deficit in the state budget
- Repeal Amendment 23
- Create a rainy day fund
- Impose a constitutional limit on annualization

Limit debt

- Impose strict limits on certificate of
- participation bonds and require supermajority vote of the legislature to issue these bonds
- Eliminate unfunded liabilities in state pension and **OPEB** Plans
- Require a supermajority vote of the legislature to propose new debt

Budget Reform

- Introduce priority budgeting
- Identify core functions of state government
- Require state agencies to evaluate programs as they relate to core functions
- Prioritize programs
- Impose a hard budget constraint

- Monitor the performance of state programs
 - Conduct performance reviews
- Create competitive sourcing center
- Conduct sunset review of state programs

- Enact transparency in government law
 - Report government expenditures on line
 - Eliminate off budget expenditures

- Reform state programs
- Eliminate earmarks
- Eliminate unfunded liabilities
- Reform entitlement programs
- Eliminate mandates
