SHORT TITLE: "Sunset Psychiatric Technicians Licensing"

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF LICENSING OF PSYCHIATRIC

## 102 TECHNICIANS BY THE STATE BOARD OF NURSING.

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#### Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Sunset Process - Senate Health and Human Services Committee. Implements the recommendations of the department of regulatory agencies in its sunset review of the licensing of psychiatric technicians by the state board of nursing as follows:

• Recommendation 1: Continues the licensing and regulation of psychiatric technicians by the state board of nursing for 5 years and then allows it to repeal without a sunset review.

• Recommendation 2: Repeals the prohibition against nurses delegating the selection of medication to someone not authorized by law to do so.

1	12-38-103 (10), subject to the requirements of this section. In no event
