## HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE REPORT

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB09-143 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, strike line 17 and substitute the  
2 following:

3 "SECTION 2. The introductory portion to 42-4-110.5 (2) and  
4 42-4-110.5 (2) (a) (II), (2) (c), (2) (g) (I), (2) (g) (II), (4) (a), (4) (b) (I),  
5 (4.5), and (5),";

6 line 21, after "A", insert "COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR";

7 after line 27, insert the following:

8 "(a) (II) If the state, a county, a city and county, or a municipality  
9 detects any alleged violation of a COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR  
10 municipal traffic regulation or a traffic violation under state law through  
11 the use of an automated vehicle identification system, then the state,  
12 county, city and county, or municipality shall serve the penalty  
13 assessment notice or summons and complaint for the alleged violation on  
14 the defendant no later than ninety days after the alleged violation  
15 occurred. If a penalty assessment notice or summons and complaint for  
16 a violation detected using an automated vehicle identification system is  
17 personally served, the state, a county, a city and county, or a municipality  
18 may only charge the actual costs of service of process that shall be no  
19 more than the amount usually charged for civil service of process.

20 (c) The state, a county, a city and county, or a municipality may  
21 not report to the department any outstanding judgment or warrant for  
22 purposes of section 42-2-107 (5) or 42-2-118 (3) based upon any  
23 violation or alleged violation of a COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR  
24 municipal traffic regulation or traffic violation under state law detected



1 through the use of an automated vehicle identification system."

2 Page 4, strike line 14, and substitute the following:

3 "(4) (a) If the state, a county, a city and county, or a municipality  
4 detects a speeding violation of less than ten miles per hour over the  
5 reasonable and prudent speed under a COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR  
6 municipal traffic regulation or under state law through the use of an  
7 automated vehicle identification system and the violation is the first  
8 violation by such driver that the state, county, city and county, or  
9 municipality has detected using an automated vehicle identification  
10 system, then the state, county, city and county, or municipality shall mail  
11 such driver a warning regarding the violation and the state, county, city  
12 and county, or municipality may not impose any penalty or surcharge for  
13 such first violation.

14 (b) (I) If the state, a county, a city and county, or a";

15 line 16, before "municipal", insert "COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR".

16 after line 23, insert the following:

17 "(4.5) If the state, a county, a city and county, or a municipality  
18 detects a violation under a COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR municipal  
19 traffic regulation or under state law for disobedience to a traffic control  
20 signal through the use of an automated vehicle identification system, the  
21 maximum penalty that the state, a county, a city and county, or a  
22 municipality may impose for such violation, including any surcharge, is  
23 seventy-five dollars.

24 (5) If the state, a county, a city and county, or a municipality has  
25 established an automated vehicle identification system for the  
26 enforcement of COUNTY, CITY AND COUNTY, OR municipal traffic  
27 regulations or state traffic laws, then no portion of any fine collected  
28 through the use of such system may be paid to the manufacturer or vendor  
29 of the automated vehicle identification system equipment. The  
30 compensation paid by the state, county, city and county, or municipality  
31 for such equipment shall be based upon the value of such equipment and  
32 may not be based upon the number of traffic citations issued or the  
33 revenue generated by such equipment."
