SUBJECT:	Governor Ritter's Latest Budget Balancing Proposal for FY 2009-10

Attached is Governor Ritter's budget balancing proposal dated January 27, 2009. Below, I have highlighted two parts of the proposal related to capital construction.

1. Reduces the Recommended Number of FY 2009-10 State-Funded Capital Requests

The Governor's Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) now recommends only four projects for funding in FY 2009-10, totaling \$45.6 million and including:

- a. University of Colorado Denver, Anschutz Certificates of Participation (COPs) --- \$5.1 million;
- b. Corrections, Colorado State Penitentiary II COP \$10.7 million;¹
- c. Level I Controlled Maintenance \$22.3 million; and
- d. Revenue, Colorado Integrated Tax Architecture (CITA) \$7.4 million.

2. Transfers the Principal Balance of, Plus Additions to, the Higher Education Maintenance and Reserve Fund (HEMRF) to the General Fund

OSPB estimates that the current principal balance of the HEMRF is \$47.2 million. In addition, OSPB recommends transferring the unspent balances of projects frozen October 1, 2008 (\$50.2 million) and of projects frozen January 15, 2009 (\$43.4 million) from the Capital Construction Fund to the HEMRF, then to the General Fund, to mitigate the higher education shortfall in FY 2008-09, FY 2009-10, and FY 2010-11. Thus, the total amount recommended for transfer is \$140.8 million.

¹ The scheduled FY 2009-10 payment is \$13.9 million. OSPB did not explain in the proposal why it recommends less than the scheduled payment.
