After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HJR09-1002 be amended as follows:

1 Amend engrossed joint resolution, page 2, line 27, strike "now,
2 therefore," and substitute "and";

3 after line 27, insert the following:

4 "WHEREAS, With the passage of the American Recovery and
5 Reinvestment Act of 2009 ("ARRA"), additional federal grant funds will
6 be provided to both the Drinking Water Revolving Fund and the Water
7 Pollution Control Revolving Fund to preserve and create jobs and
8 promote economic recovery; and

9 WHEREAS, To ensure that all additional funds appropriated to the
10 state under the ARRA are fully utilized, the Water Quality Control
11 Commission held a rulemaking hearing on March 9, 2009, to establish an
12 additional category (Category Six) of projects eligible for potential
13 funding from the Drinking Water Revolving Fund and the Water
14 Pollution Control Revolving Fund and has developed a list of Category
15 Six projects to be included on the Drinking Water Revolving Fund and
16 the Water Pollution Control Project Eligibility List as set forth in Sections
17 7 and 8 below; now, therefore,".

18 Page 12, after line 16, insert the following:

19 "7. That the following projects are included as Category Six
20 projects on the Drinking Water Project Eligibility List as defined in
21 section 37-95-103 (4.8) and pursuant to 37-95-107.8 (4) (c), Colorado
