## REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL REQUEST

Fort Lewis College (FLC) is requesting additional cash funds spending authority to address below-cost estimates and escalating construction costs. Animas Hall, the new residence hall, is under construction and nearing completion. According to FLC, the cost estimate for the project was developed by an independent contractor using a database of information for similar projects nationwide. During the project design, FLC learned that the cost estimates included in the program plan did not adequately reflect local market conditions or construction inflation of about 1 percent per month. FLC says the program plan has been amended to reflect additional costs for professional services, project contingencies, and furnishing, fixtures, and equipment.

Additional funds for the project include \$2.2 million in revenue bonds included in the original issuance for the project and repaid from revenues from auxiliary enterprises, and \$500,000 from auxiliary enterprise revenues that the college has on hand.

## Summary of Project

The project constructs a new 49,538-GSF residence hall for freshman students. The project is intended to help the college establish the eastern edge of campus as its sole residential core, and is the college's first step in renewing its housing facilities. The project is under construction and will be completed in July 2009. According to FLC, the new residence hall is already booked to full occupancy for the fall 2009 semester.

The 168-bed residence hall will have 42 four-person units. A unit will include two double-occupancy or four single-occupancy bedrooms, two bathrooms, a common living room, and a kitchenette area with a small refrigerator and

microwave. The building will be designed as a living learning community with a multi-purpose room that can be used as a classroom or for academic programming, and a faculty-in-residence apartment. The building will also have resident support space, including a lounge, front desk, and laundry.

This is a Senate Bill 92-202 request, meaning the project will be designed, constructed, operated, and maintained with non-state money.
