Bill Summary

river outfitters pursuant to the provisions of the sunset law. Sections 1, 2, and 3 of the bill extend the river outfitting licensure program until September 1, 2019. Section 4 creates a flat water guide qualification category, requires all guides to be trained in cardiopulmonary resuscitation, directs the board of parks and outdoor recreation to designate by rule certain river segments as flat water, and repeals the guide qualification exemption for designated faculty members of institutions of higher education in charge of water sport activity courses. Section 5 specifies that it is a class 2 misdemeanor for a flat water guide, flat water trip leader, or flat water instructor to provide regulated services on waters that have not been designated as flat water. Sections 6 and 7 broaden the definition of "advertise" in connection with the licensure requirement.

SECTION 7. 33-32-104 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

33-32-104. License required - fee. (1) No person shall act in the capacity of a paid river outfitter or advertise in any newspaper or magazine or any other trade publication or represent himself OR HERSELF as a river outfitter in this state without first obtaining a river outfitter's license in accordance with rules and regulations prescribed by the board.

SECTION 8. Act subject to petition - effective date - applicability. (1) This act shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 11, 2010, if adjournment sine die is on May 12, 2010); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2010 and shall take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor. < {do
