## HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE REPORT

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB10-1209 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and  
2 substitute:

3 "SECTION 1. 42-2-114, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended  
4 BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

5 **42-2-114. License issued - fees - repeal.** (10) (a) AT THE  
6 APPLICANT'S VOLUNTARY REQUEST, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A  
7 DRIVER'S LICENSE BEARING AN IDENTIFIER OF A BRANCH OF THE UNITED  
8 STATES ARMED FORCES, SUCH AS "MARINE CORPS", "NAVY", "ARMY",  
9 "AIR FORCE", OR "COAST GUARD", IF THE APPLICANT POSSESSES A  
10 CURRENTLY VALID MILITARY IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENT, A DD214 FORM  
11 ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT, OR ANY OTHER DOCUMENT  
12 ACCEPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT THAT DEMONSTRATES THAT THE  
13 APPLICANT IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OR A VETERAN OF THE BRANCH OF  
14 SERVICE THAT THE APPLICANT HAS REQUESTED BE PLACED ON THE  
15 DRIVER'S LICENSE.

16 (b) (I) TO BE ISSUED A DRIVER'S LICENSE BEARING A BRANCH OF  
17 SERVICE IDENTIFIER, THE APPLICANT SHALL PAY A FEE OF FIFTEEN  
18 DOLLARS TO THE DEPARTMENT, WHICH SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO ANY  
19 OTHER FEE FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSFER  
20 THE FEE TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE FEE TO THE  
21 HIGHWAY USERS TAX FUND, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II)  
22 OF THIS PARAGRAPH (b).

23 (II) (A) THE DEPARTMENT MAY RETAIN UP TO NINETY-EIGHT



1 THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-EIGHT DOLLARS OF THE FEES  
2 COLLECTED PURSUANT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (b) AS  
3 NECESSARY TO OFFSET THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COST OF IMPLEMENTING  
4 THIS SUBSECTION (10).

5 (B) THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (II) IS REPEALED EFFECTIVE JULY 1,  
6 2012.

7 (c) (I) THIS SUBSECTION (10) IS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011.

8 (II) THIS PARAGRAPH (c) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011.

9 SECTION 2. 42-2-303, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended  
10 BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

11 **42-2-303. Contents of identification card.** (4) (a) AT THE  
12 APPLICANT'S VOLUNTARY REQUEST, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE AN  
13 IDENTIFICATION CARD BEARING AN IDENTIFIER OF A BRANCH OF THE  
14 UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES, SUCH AS "MARINE CORPS", "NAVY",  
15 "ARMY", "AIR FORCE", OR "COAST GUARD", IF THE APPLICANT POSSESSES  
16 A CURRENTLY VALID MILITARY IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENT, A DD214  
17 FORM ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT, OR ANY OTHER  
18 DOCUMENT ACCEPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT THAT DEMONSTRATES THAT  
19 THE APPLICANT IS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OR A VETERAN OF THE BRANCH OF  
20 SERVICE THAT THE APPLICANT HAS REQUESTED BE PLACED ON THE  
21 IDENTIFICATION CARD.

22 (b) TO BE ISSUED AN IDENTIFICATION CARD BEARING A BRANCH OF  
23 SERVICE IDENTIFIER, THE APPLICANT SHALL PAY A FEE OF FIFTEEN  
24 DOLLARS TO THE DEPARTMENT, WHICH SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO ANY  
25 OTHER FEE FOR AN IDENTIFICATION CARD. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL  
26 TRANSFER THE FEE TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE FEE  
27 TO THE HIGHWAY USERS TAX FUND.

28 (c) (I) THIS SUBSECTION (4) IS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011.

29 (II) THIS PARAGRAPH (c) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011.

30 SECTION 3. **Specified effective date - applicability.** This act  
31 shall take effect July 1, 2010, and shall apply to driver's licenses and  
32 identification cards issued on or after said date.



1           **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
2 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
3 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety."

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
