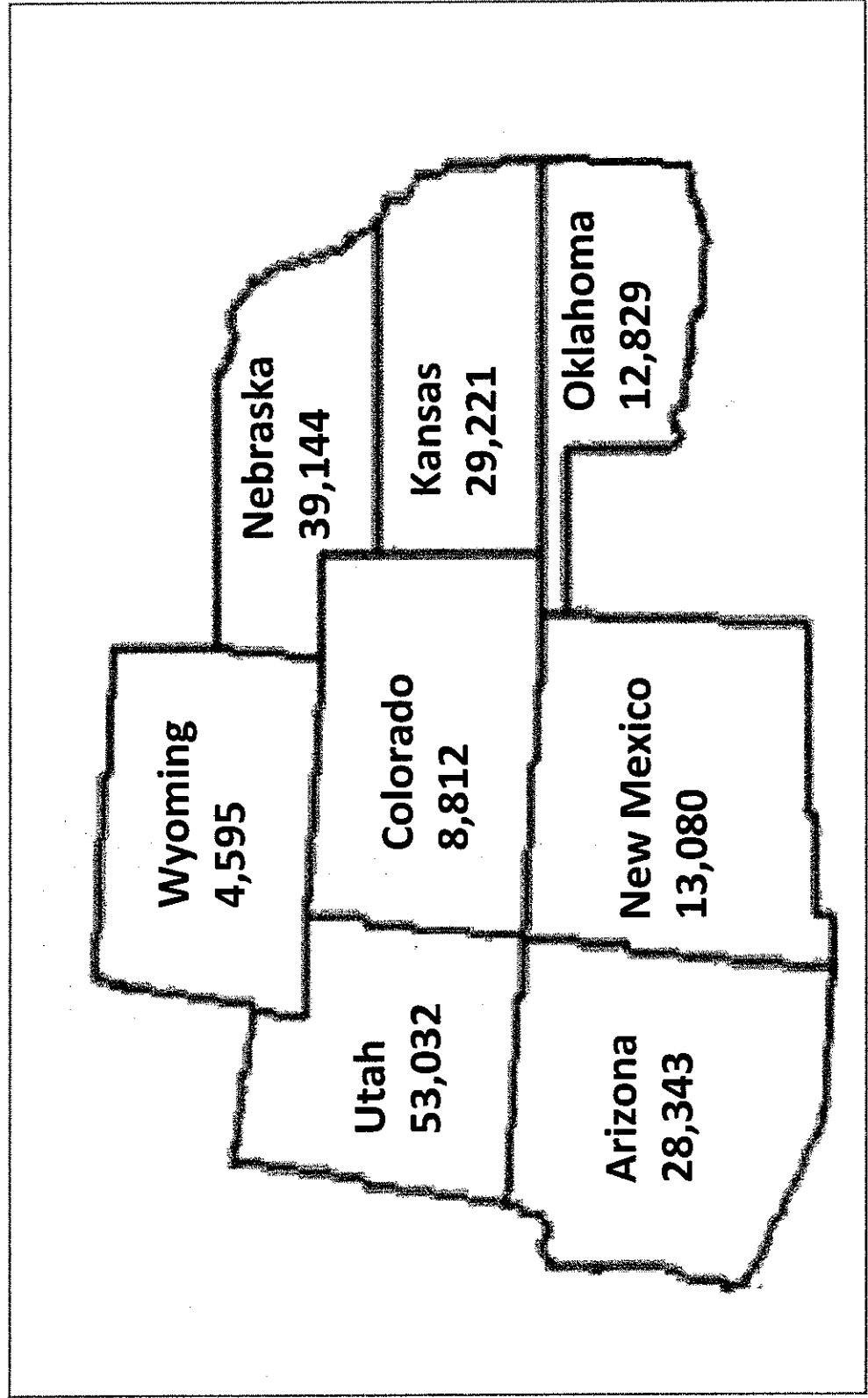


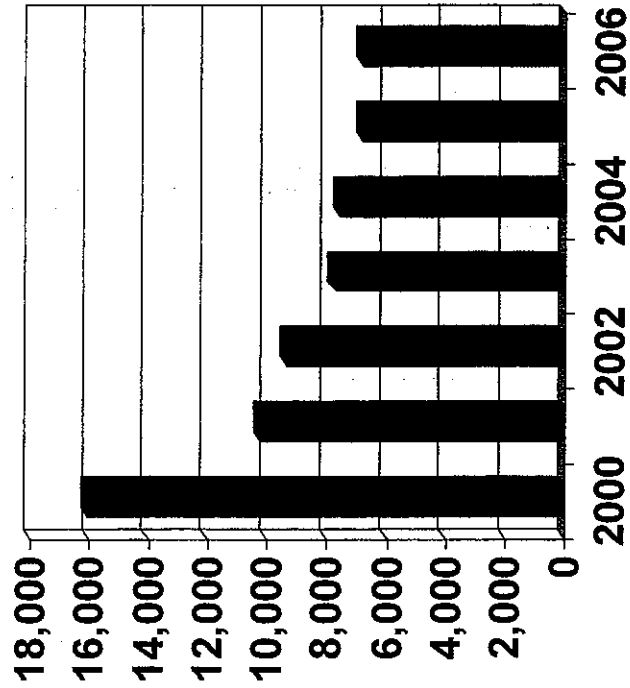
Truck Tractor Registrations – 2008

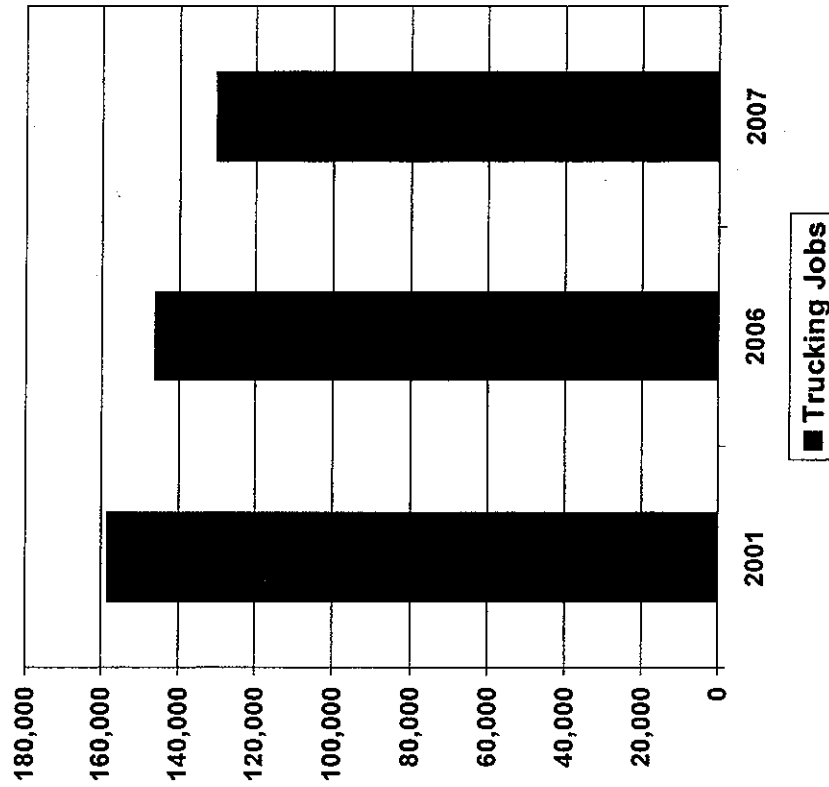
Decline of Interstate Truck Tractor Registrations in Colorado

- Interstate Truck Registrations in Colorado have dropped 57% since the year 2000
- A further drop in truck registrations is anticipated in the upcoming years as more companies move their operations to adjacent states which have a better tax environment

Trucking Industry Employment 2001 - 2007



- Trucking industry has seen a steady decline in jobs over the last several years.
- Since 2001 Colo. has seen a loss of over 28,000 jobs. Drop of almost 16,000 jobs from 2006 to 2007. Job loss has continued and losses may be greater than in 2007.
