## HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE REPORT

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB10-1279 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 10, line 6, after "(1) (h) (III)," insert "(5) (a)  
2 (I),".

3 Page 10, after line 18 insert:

4           "(a) (I) (A) To sell an alcohol beverage to any person under the  
5 age of twenty-one years, to a habitual drunkard, or to a visibly intoxicated  
6 person, or to permit any alcohol beverage to be sold or dispensed by a  
7 person under eighteen years of age, or to permit any such person to  
8 participate in the sale or dispensing thereof. If a person who, in fact, is  
9 not twenty-one years of age exhibits a fraudulent proof of age, any action  
10 relying on such fraudulent proof of age shall not constitute grounds for  
11 the revocation or suspension of any license issued under this article or  
12 article 46 of this title.

13           (B) Notwithstanding any provision in this subparagraph (I) to the  
14 contrary, ~~no~~ A person under twenty-one years of age shall MAY be  
15 employed to sell or dispense malt, vinous, or spirituous liquors ~~unless he~~  
16 ~~or she~~ IF THE PERSON is supervised by another person EMPLOYEE who is  
17 on ~~premise~~ THE LICENSED PREMISES and ~~has attained~~ IS AT LEAST  
18 twenty-one years of age; ~~No~~ EXCEPT THAT, AN employee of a tavern  
19 licensed pursuant to section 12-47-412, that does not regularly serve  
20 meals as defined in section 12-47-103 (20), A LIQUOR-LICENSED  
21 DRUGSTORE, or a retail liquor store shall NOT sell malt, vinous, or  
22 spirituous liquors ~~unless such person~~ IF THE EMPLOYEE is NOT at least  
23 twenty-one years of age.



1           (C) NOTWITHSTANDING SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH (B) OF THIS  
2 SUBPARAGRAPH (I), A RETAIL LIQUOR STORE OR LIQUOR-LICENSED  
3 DRUGSTORE MAY EMPLOY A PERSON WHO IS AT LEAST EIGHTEEN YEARS OF  
4 AGE TO HANDLE OR STOCK MALT, VINOUS, AND SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS IF THE  
5 PERSON IS UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF AN EMPLOYEE ON THE  
6 LICENSED PREMISES WHO IS AT LEAST TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE. AN  
7 EMPLOYEE OF A RETAIL LIQUOR STORE OR LIQUOR-LICENSED DRUGSTORE  
8 WHO IS LESS THAN TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE SHALL NOT SELL, DELIVER,  
9 OR CARRY MALT, VINOUS, OR SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS TO A CUSTOMER'S  
10 VEHICLE, AND SHALL NOT CHECK PROOF OF AGE OF A CUSTOMER  
11 ATTEMPTING TO PURCHASE MALT, VINOUS, OR SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS."
