After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following: HB10-1408 be amended as follows: 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 5 through 7 and substitute: "congressional districts. (1) In determining whether one or more of the 2 congressional districts established in section 2-1-101 are lawful and in 3 adopting or enforcing any change to any such district, courts: 4 5 (a) Shall UTILIZE THE FOLLOWING FACTORS:". 6 Page 2, strike lines 15 through 27 and substitute: 7 "(I) First, A good faith effort to achieve precise mathematical population equality between districts, justifying each variance, no matter 8 how small, as required by the constitution of the United States. Each 9 district shall consist of contiguous whole general election precincts. 10 11 Districts shall not overlap; 12 (II) Second, Compliance with the federal "Voting Rights Act of 1965", in particular 42 U.S.C. sec. 1973; AND 13 14 "(b) May, without weight to any factor, utilize factors 15 INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO: (HH I) Third, Except when necessary to comply with subparagraph 16 (I) or (II) of this paragraph (b) THE PRESERVATION OF political 17 subdivisions such as counties, cities, and towns. shall be preserved intact 18 and shall not be fragmented or dispersed across district lines. When 19



- applying this criterion, preservation of the most populous counties, cities,
 and towns shall take precedence. When county, city, or town boundaries
 are changed, adjustments, if any, in districts shall be as prescribed by law.
- 4 (FV II) Fourth, THE PRESERVATION OF communities of interest, including ethnic, cultural, economic, trade area, geographic, and demographic factors. shall be preserved within a single district whenever possible. Traditional communities of interest in Colorado include the western slope and the eastern plains.
- 9 (V III) Fifth, Each THE COMPACTNESS OF EACH congressional district; shall be as compact in area as possible, and the aggregate linear distance of all district boundaries shall be as short as possible; and
- 12 (VI IV) Sixth, THE MINIMIZATION OF disruption of prior district lines. shall be minimized."
- 14 Page 3, strike lines 1 through 10.
- 15 Page 1, line 101, strike "THE REPEAL OF".
