2. Requested dates to exhibit in 2011

- Installation date on Fri. June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2011, or Mon. June 6<sup>th</sup> 2011, which ever best suits your preference for summer visitors.
- CQC plans to continue to use Freeman Co. The professional crew contracted to conduct a safe one day job of hanging the exhibit. Total time to install the show is usually 7 to 8 hours. Approximately 25 CQC volunteers assist in this production.

3. Official Opening Reception date for the CQC Capitol Quilt Show '11

- This function takes place in The Old Supreme Court Chambers, typically on the first Fri. following the day of installation. If accepted, that would make Fri. June 10<sup>th</sup> 2011 the recommended date. The required permits will be issued in addition to this event being sponsored by the appropriate Capitol Building representative.

4. Suggested date to conclude the quilt show

- To receive the best exposure for all visitors to attend the Colorado State Capitol /CQC Quilt Show, we recommendation is to run the exhibit through Fri. Aug. 19, 2011. Scheduling Mon. Aug. 22, 2011 as the date to dismantle. Freeman Co. will be hired to complete this task. Approximately 25 CQC volunteers will assist.
