After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB10-1354 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 9, line 8, strike "article 1.9 of title 18," and
2 substitute "18-1.9-103,".

3 Page 9, strike lines 24 through 27.

4 Page 10, strike lines 1 through 6 and substitute:

5 "SECTION 4. 18-1.9-101 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
6 amended to read:

7 **18-1.9-101. Legislative declaration.** (4) Therefore, the general
8 assembly declares that it is necessary to create a task force to continue to
9 examine the identification, diagnosis, and treatment of persons with
10 mental illness who are involved in the state criminal and juvenile justice
11 systems and to make additional recommendations to a ~~legislative~~
12 ~~oversight committee~~ THE JUDICIARY COMMITTEES OF THE HOUSE OF
13 REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE, OR ANY SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES, for
14 the continuing development of legislative proposals related to this issue.

15 **SECTION 5.** 18-1.9-102, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended

17 **18-1.9-102. Definitions.** As used in this article, unless the context

1 (1.5) (1) "Co-occurring disorder" means a disorder that commonly
2 coincides with mental illness and may include, but is not limited to, substance
3 abuse, developmental disability, fetal alcohol syndrome, and traumatic brain
4 injury.

5 (2) "JOINT COMMITTEE CHAIRS" MEANS THE CHAIRS OF THE JUDICIARY
6 COMMITTEES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE, OR ANY
7 SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES.

8 (3) "JOINT JUDICIARY COMMITTEES" MEANS THE JUDICIARY
9 COMMITTEES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE, OR ANY
10 SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES, MEETING JOINTLY.

11 (2) (4) "Task force" means the task force for the continuing
12 examination of the treatment of persons with mental illness who are involved
13 in the criminal and juvenile justice systems established pursuant to section
14 18-1.9-104.

15 **SECTION 6.** The introductory portion to 18-1.9-104 (1) (c),
16 18-1.9-104 (1) (e), the introductory portion to 18-1.9-104 (3), 18-1.9-104
17 (3) (b), and the introductory portion to 18-1.9-104 (3) (e), Colorado
18 Revised Statutes, are amended to read:

19 **18-1.9-104. Mentally ill offender task force - creation - membership**
20 **- duties.** (1) **Creation.** (c) The ~~chair and vice-chair of the committee~~ JOINT
21 COMMITTEE CHAIRS shall appoint twenty-six members as follows:

22 (e) A vacancy occurring in a position filled by the ~~chair and vice-chair~~
23 ~~of the~~ JOINT committee CHAIRS pursuant to paragraph (c) of this subsection (1)
24 shall be filled as soon as possible by the ~~chair and vice-chair of the~~ JOINT
25 committee CHAIRS in accordance with the limitations specified in paragraph (c)
26 of this subsection (1). In addition, the ~~chair and vice-chair of the~~ JOINT
27 committee CHAIRS may remove and replace any appointment to the task force
28 made pursuant to paragraph (c) of this subsection (1).

29 (3) **Additional duties of the task force.** The task force shall provide
30 guidance and make findings and recommendations to the ~~committee for its~~
31 ~~development of reports and legislative recommendations~~ JOINT JUDICIARY
32 COMMITTEES for modification of the criminal and juvenile justice systems, with
33 respect to persons with mental illness who are involved in these systems. In
34 addition, the task force shall:

35 (b) Meet at least six times each year from the date of the first meeting
36 until January 1, 2015, or more often as directed by the ~~chair of the~~ JOINT

2 (e) Submit a report to the committee by ~~October 1, 2004, and by each~~
3 ~~October 1 thereafter through October 1, 2014~~ JOINT JUDICIARY COMMITTEES BY
4 JANUARY 20, 2011, AND BY JANUARY 20 EACH YEAR THEREAFTER THROUGH
5 2015. At a minimum, ~~specifying~~ THE REPORT SHALL SPECIFY the following:
