After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB10-1287 be amended as follows:

1 Strike the State, Veterans, & Military Affairs Committee Report, dated
2 February 23, 2010, and substitute:

3 "Amended printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
4 substitute:

5 "SECTION 1. Legislative declaration. (1) The general
6 assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that:

7 (a) The state of Colorado should generally limit the use of
8 state-owned motor vehicles to official state business, but incidental
9 personal use is sometimes unavoidable, reasonable, and for the benefit of
10 the state;

11 (b) Regular personal use of state-owned motor vehicles for
12 commuting is considered to be a fringe benefit, and in most instances
13 employees should fairly and fully reimburse the state for this personal
14 use;

15 (c) Unreimbursed fringe benefits may be subject to federal and
16 state taxation; and

17 (d) Actual vehicle operating costs and reimbursements for
18 commuting must be reported accurately to ensure appropriate oversight
19 of state assets, preparation of the state budget, and compliance with
20 federal and state laws.
