2	SECTION 1. Repeal. 2-3-1203 (3) (w) (III), Colorado Revised
3	Statutes, is repealed as follows:
4	2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees. (3) The

6	designated advisory committees is scheduled for repeal:

8	(III) The forestry advisory board, created in section 24-33-202,

10	SECTION 2. 24-1-124 (3) (j), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
11	amended to read:
12	24-1-124. Department of natural resources - creation -
13	divisions. (3) The department of natural resources shall consist of the
14	following divisions:
15	(j) The division of forestry, created in section 24-33-201 (1), the
16	head of which shall be the state forester, appointed pursuant to section
17	23-31-207, C.R.S. and the forestry advisory board, created in section
18	24-33-202 (1). The division of forestry AND the state forester and the
19	forestry advisory board shall exercise their powers, duties, and functions
20	as prescribed by law under the department of natural resources and the
21	executive director thereof as if the same were transferred to the
22	department by a type 2 transfer.

14	(1) There is hereby created a forestry advisory board in the department
15	of natural resources for the purpose of assisting the governor, the
16	executive director of the department of natural resources, and the division
17	of forestry with establishing state forest policy. The board shall consist
18	of seven members. Three members shall include the executive director
19	of the department of natural resources or the executive director's
20	designee, the president of Colorado state university or the president's
21	designee, and the commissioner of agriculture or the commissioner's
22	designee. Four members shall be appointed by the governor and shall
23	serve three-year terms. Of these four members, one shall be a local
24	government representative, one shall be a private land owner with forest
25	land in the state, one shall be a representative of the forest products
26	industry, and one shall be a representative of an organization dedicated
27	to forest and wildlife habitat preservation.

1	(2) Members of the forestry advisory board shall serve without
2	compensation but are entitled to reimbursement of actual and necessary
3	expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
4	(3) This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2010. Prior to such
5	repeal, the forestry advisory board shall be reviewed as provided for in
6	section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.
7	SECTION 6. Specified effective date. This act shall take effect
8	July 1, 2010.
9	SECTION 7. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
10	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
11	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
