The governing 7 body having jurisdiction may levy a solid wastes disposal site and facility 8 tax, in addition to any other tax authorized by law, on the taxable property 9 within such A county or municipality, the proceeds of which shall be 10 deposited to the credit of said fund and appropriated to pay the cost of 11 land, labor, equipment, and services needed in the operation of solid 12 wastes disposal sites and facilities and for any other solid wastes 13 management purpose in or on behalf of that county or municipality. Any 14 governing body having jurisdiction is also authorized, after a public 15 hearing, to fix, modify, and collect service charges from users of solid 16 wastes disposal sites and facilities or transfer stations for the purpose of financing solid wastes management in that county or municipality. In the 17 18 event that a countywide solid waste disposal site and facility tax has been 19 imposed with the consent of a majority of the voters in the county, that 20 tax may continue to be collected countywide and may accrue to the 21 county's solid waste disposal site and facility fund, notwithstanding any 22 subsequent taxes as may be levied by any municipalities within the county 23 under this section.

4	OPERATED SITE AND FACILITY THAT IS FOR THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF
5	PROCESSING, RECLAIMING, OR RECYCLING:
6	(I) RECYCLABLE MATERIALS;
7	(II) EXCLUDED SCRAP METAL;
8	(III) AUTO PARTS; OR
9	(IV) SCRAP THAT IS COMPOSED OF WORN OUT METAL OR A METAL
10	PRODUCT THAT HAS OUTLIVED ITS ORIGINAL USE, COMMONLY REFERRED
11	TO AS OBSOLETE SCRAP.
12	(b) NOTHING IN THIS SUBSECTION (2) SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO
13	PROHIBIT ANY GOVERNING BODY HAVING JURISDICTION FROM LEVYING OR
14	COLLECTING SERVICE CHARGES FROM USERS OF A SOLID WASTES DISPOSAL
15	SITE AND FACILITY AT WHICH RECYCLING OCCURS.".
