Description:

An 11-member board, 10 members who are appointed by the Governor and one who is the Commissioner of Agriculture or a designee. Of the 10 members appointed by the Governor, two shall be residents of the county in which the state fair is held and of the eight remaining members at least one shall be a resident of each of the congressional districts and at least two shall be residents of the western slope. Of the 10 appointed members, one shall be a certified public accountant, one shall have expertise in finance through current management-level experience in banking, and one shall have substantial experience in agriculture or in the activities of 4-H clubs. At no time shall more than six members of the board be affiliated with the same political party as the Governor. The board meets at least monthly.

Appointments made to the board when the Senate is not in session shall be temporary appointments, and the appointees shall serve on a temporary basis until the Senate is in session and can confirm the appointments. Each member shall hold office until the member's successor is appointed and qualified.

The board's duties include providing for the fair subject to available appropriations by the general assembly; entering into agreements with other state government agencies to provide for the fair; hiring and employing the manager of the state fair authority; submitting annual reports by October 31 of each year to the Governor, the General Assembly, the Joint Budget Committee, and the Legislative Audit Committee; adopting rules; and accepting contributions.
