**Description:**

The board shall consist of two public members from each congressional district. No two representatives of any one congressional district shall be of the same political party. The public members are appointed by the Governor subject to consent of the Senate. Two members shall reside west of the Continental Divide and one member shall represent agricultural interest. The public members are entitled to reasonable per diem as determined by the board, plus their actual expenses. A representative shall be designated by State Board of Parks and Outdoor Recreation and one designated by the Colorado Wildlife Commission. The Executive Director of the Department of Natural Resources also serves.

The board has the power to direct the Treasurer to disburse expendable income from the trust fund as determined by resolution, and otherwise to administer the trust fund, provided, however, that the board shall not have the power to acquire any interest in real property other than to temporarily hold real property donated to it, and to acquire leased office space. The board may also promulgate rules and regulations necessary for the conduct of their affairs so long as they give the public an opportunity to comment on the general policies and upon specific grant proposals before the board. They shall publish an annual financial report to the public, Governor, and General Assembly and consult with the General Assembly from time to time concerning its objectives and its budget.


