Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB10-109 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 11, after line 20 insert:

2           **"SECTION 5. Appropriation.** (1) In addition to any other  
3 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the  
4 medical marijuana program cash fund created in section 25-1.5-106 (8),  
5 Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department  
6 of public health and environment, for the fiscal year beginning July 1,  
7 2010, the sum of eight hundred fifteen thousand two hundred twenty-four  
8 dollars (\$815,224) cash funds and 2.1 FTE, or so much thereof as may be  
9 necessary, for the implementation of this act. Of said appropriation,  
10 ninety-nine thousand eight hundred seventy-nine dollars (\$99,879) shall  
11 be allocated to the administration and support division and seven hundred  
12 fifteen thousand three hundred forty-five dollars (\$715,345) and 2.1 FTE  
13 shall be allocated to the center for health and environmental information.

14           (2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby  
15 appropriated to the department of regulatory agencies, for the fiscal year  
16 beginning July 1, 2010, the sum of five hundred ninety-three thousand  
17 three hundred thirty-three dollars (\$593,333) and 1.2 FTE, for the  
18 investigation and prosecution of physicians referred to the board of  
19 medical examiners pursuant to section 25-1.5-106 (5), Colorado Revised  
20 Statutes, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the implementation  
21 of this act. Said appropriation shall be from reappropriated funds  
22 received from the department of public health and environment out of the

1 appropriation made in subsection (1) of this section to the center for  
2 health and environmental information. Of said appropriation, five  
3 hundred twelve thousand five hundred eighty-four dollars (\$512,584)  
4 shall be allocated to the executive director's office and eighty thousand  
5 seven hundred forty-nine dollars (\$80,749) and 1.2 FTE shall be allocated  
6 to the division of registrations.

7 (3) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby  
8 appropriated to the department of law, for the fiscal year beginning July  
9 1, 2010, the sum of six hundred twelve thousand four hundred sixty-three  
10 dollars (\$612,463) and 5.2 FTE, or so much thereof as may be necessary,  
11 for the provision of legal services to the department of public health and  
12 environment and the department of regulatory agencies related to the  
13 implementation of this act. Of said appropriation, ninety-nine thousand  
14 eight hundred seventy-nine dollars (\$99,879) shall be from reappropriated  
15 funds received from the department of public health and environment out  
16 of the appropriation made in subsection (1) of this section to the  
17 administration and support division and five hundred twelve thousand  
18 five hundred eighty-four dollars (\$512,584) shall be from reappropriated  
19 funds received from the department of regulatory agencies out of the  
20 appropriation made in subsection (2) of this section to the executive  
21 director's office."

22 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

23 Page 1, line 102, strike "PATIENTS." and substitute "PATIENTS, AND  
24 MAKING APPROPRIATIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH."
