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**Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 2/19/2010 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note Was Prepared (Amended by the Business Affairs and Labor Committee 2/24/2010)**

The Business Affairs and Labor Committee Report made the following changes:

- Amended the definition for "Fire suppression system";
- Removed language requiring the advisory board establish an examination for a sprinkler fitter;
- Inserted language allowing a person enrolled in a sprinkler fitter apprenticeship program to perform work on a fire suppression system under the direct supervision of and in the immediate presence of a sprinkler fitter; and
- Amended the definition of "Plumbing".

These amendments do not change the fiscal impact of the bill. Legislative Council Staff concurs with this JBC staff assessment.
