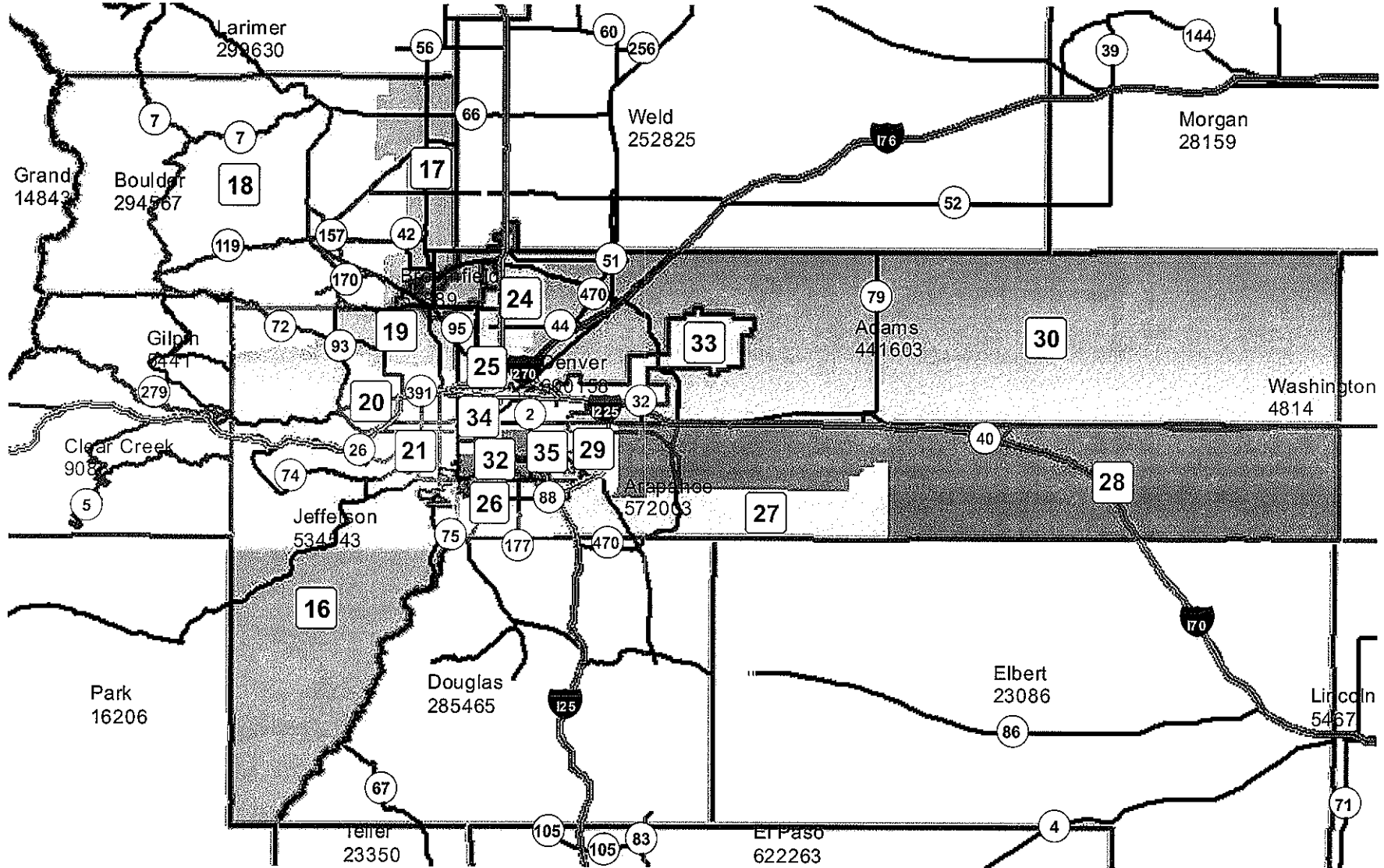

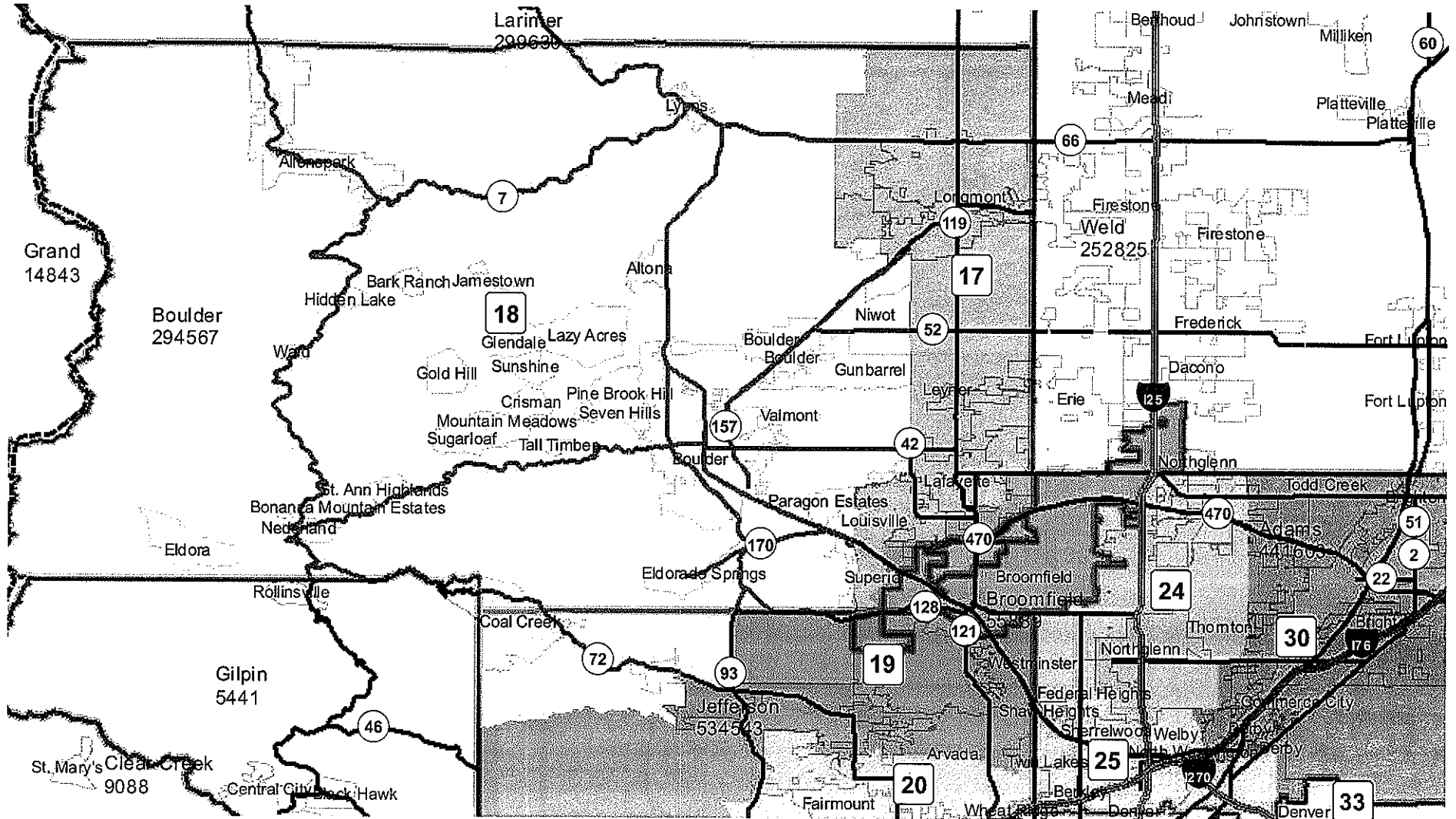

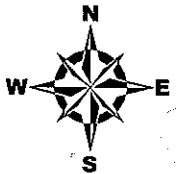

## Boulder County Zoom

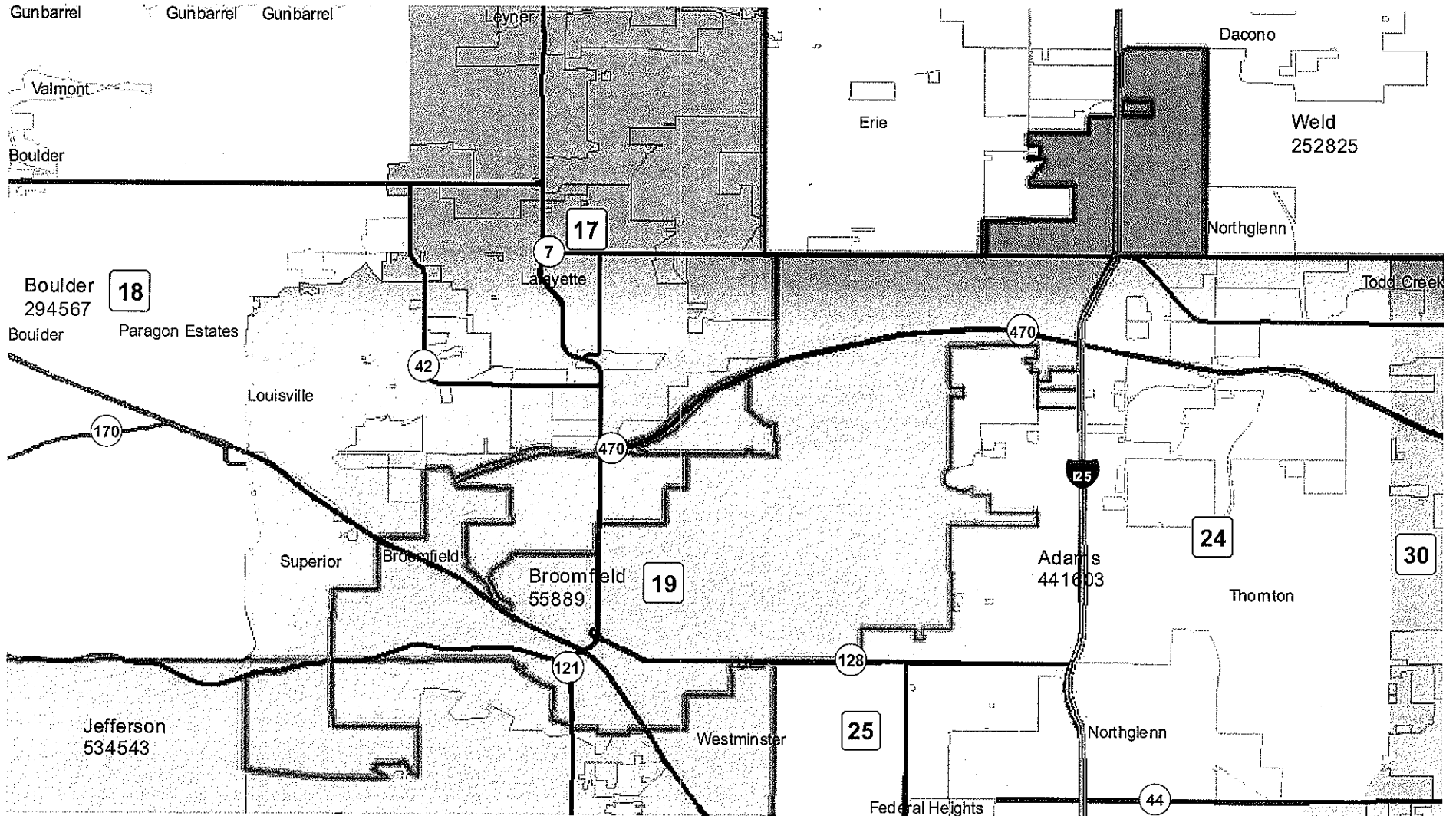

## Broomfield Zoom

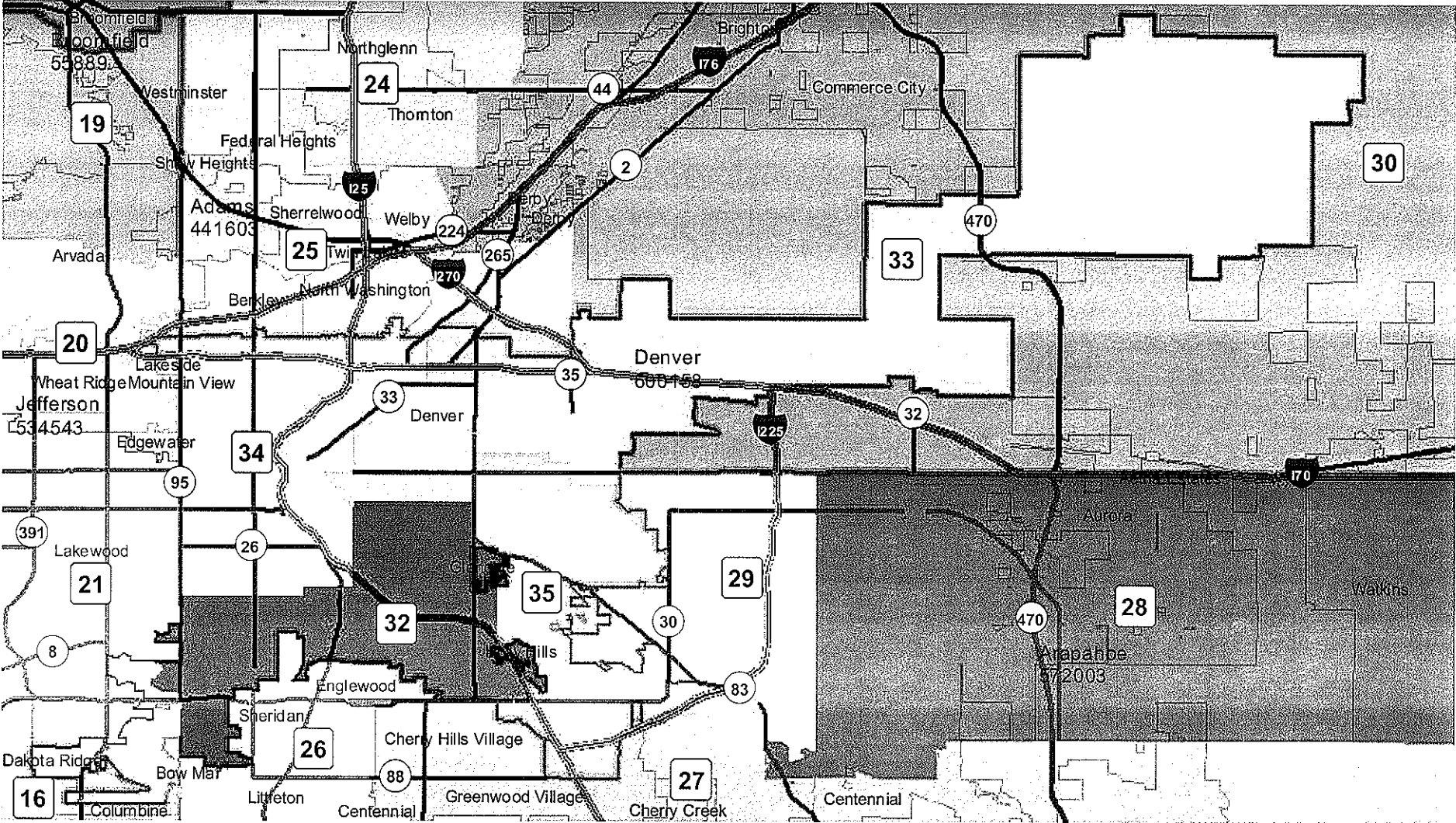

## Denver Zoom

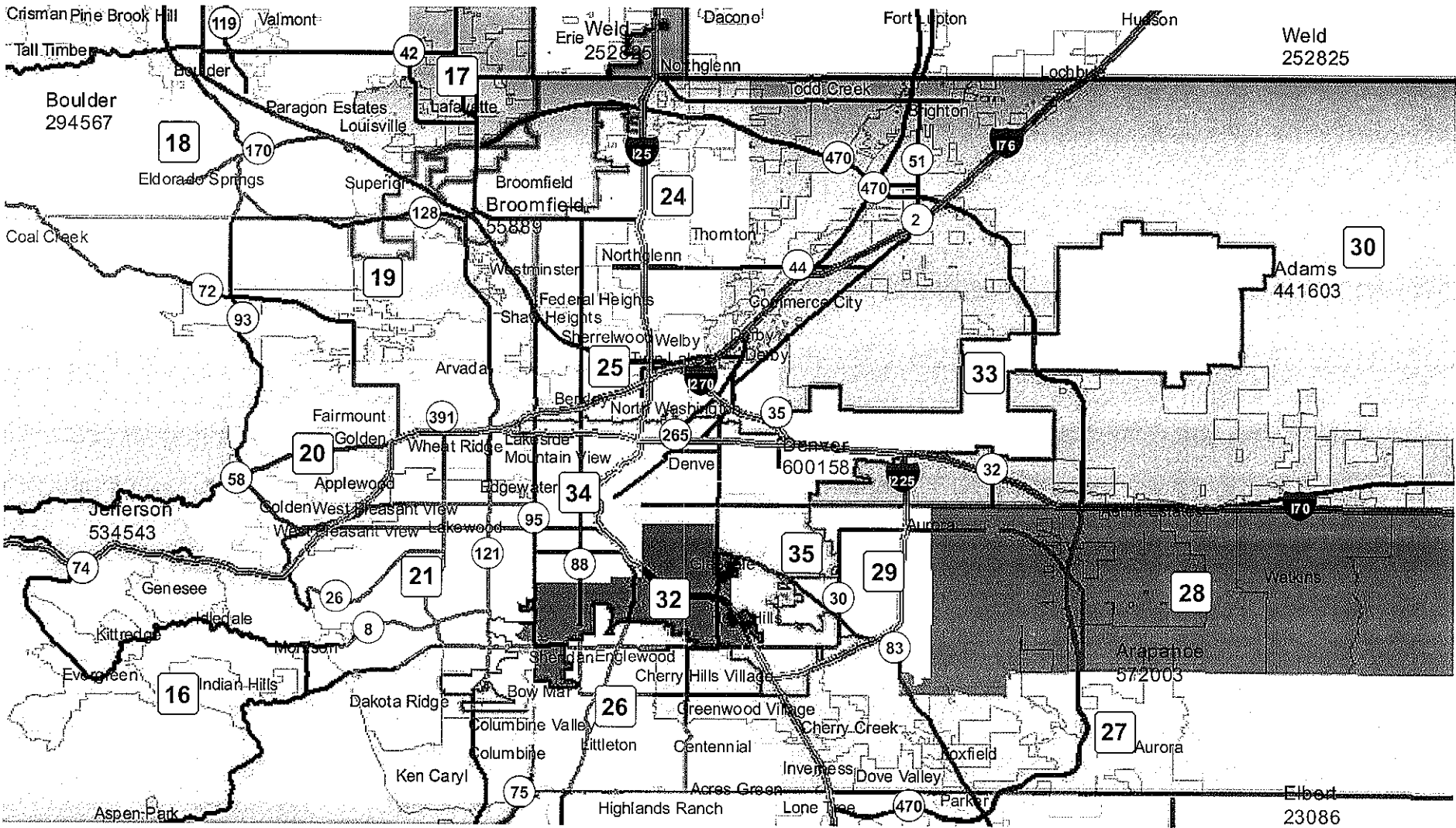


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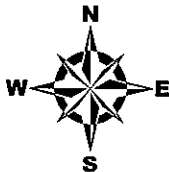

## Metro Zoom

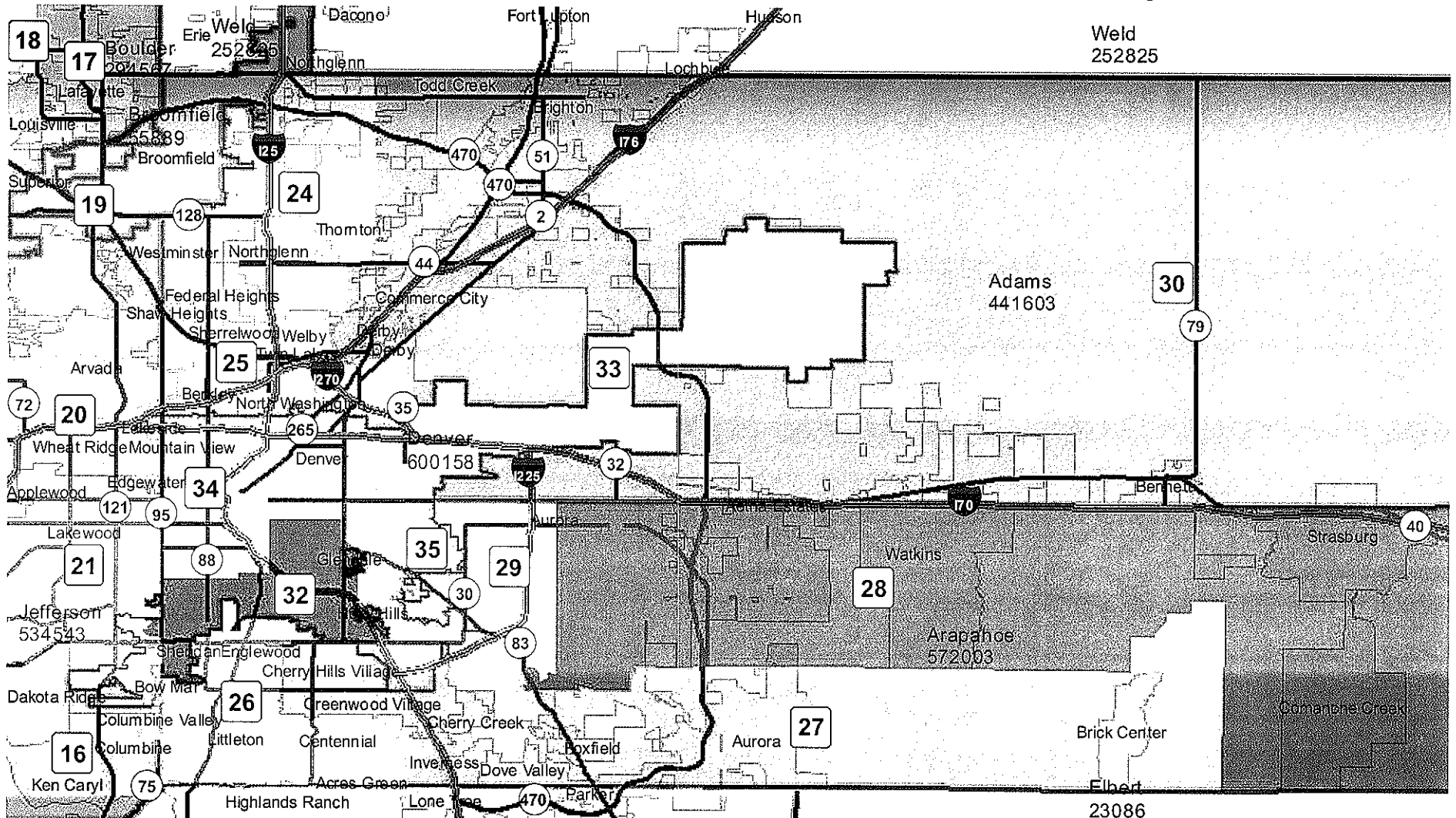

## Adams County and Arapahoe County Zoom

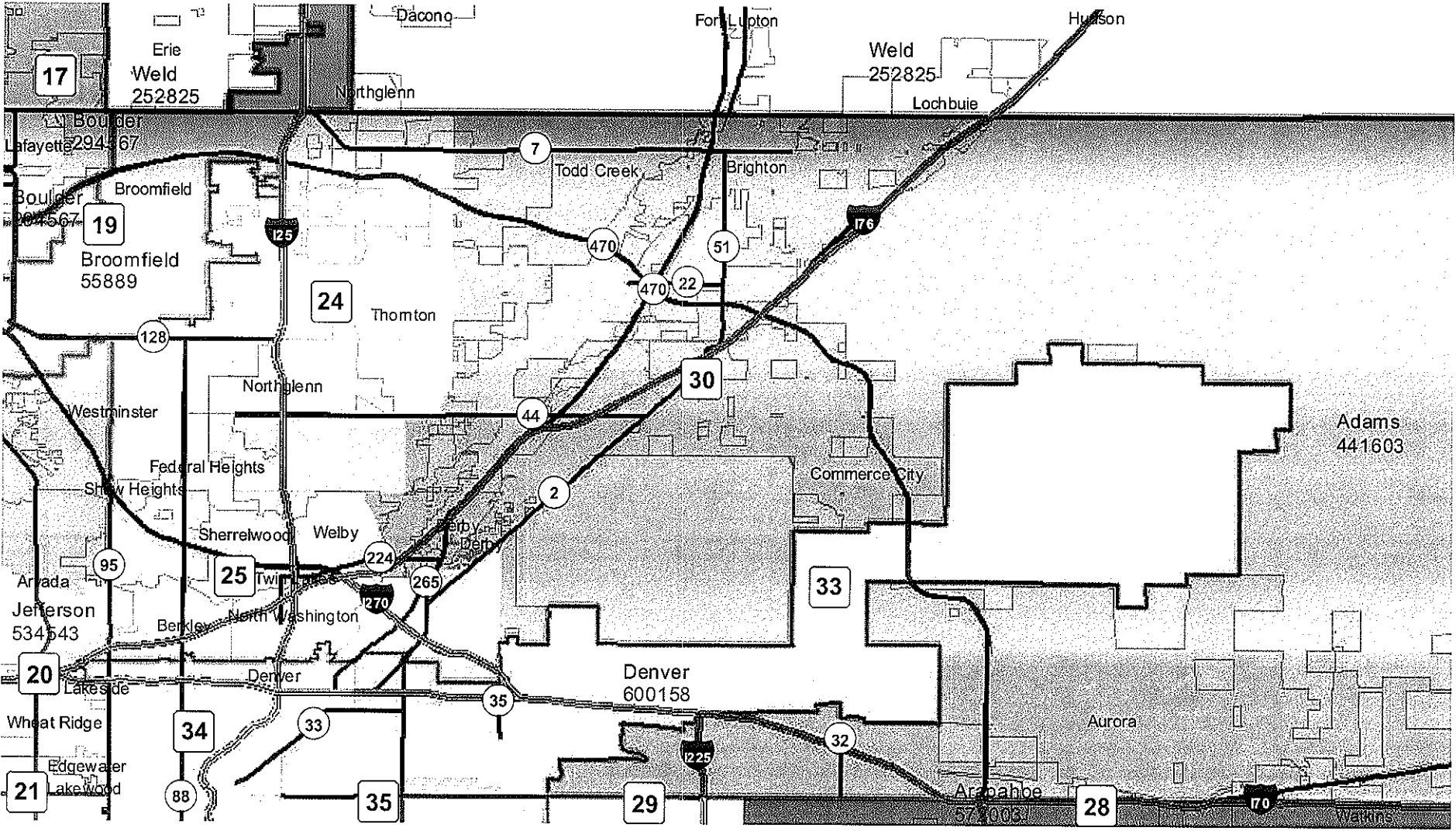

## Western Adams County Zoom

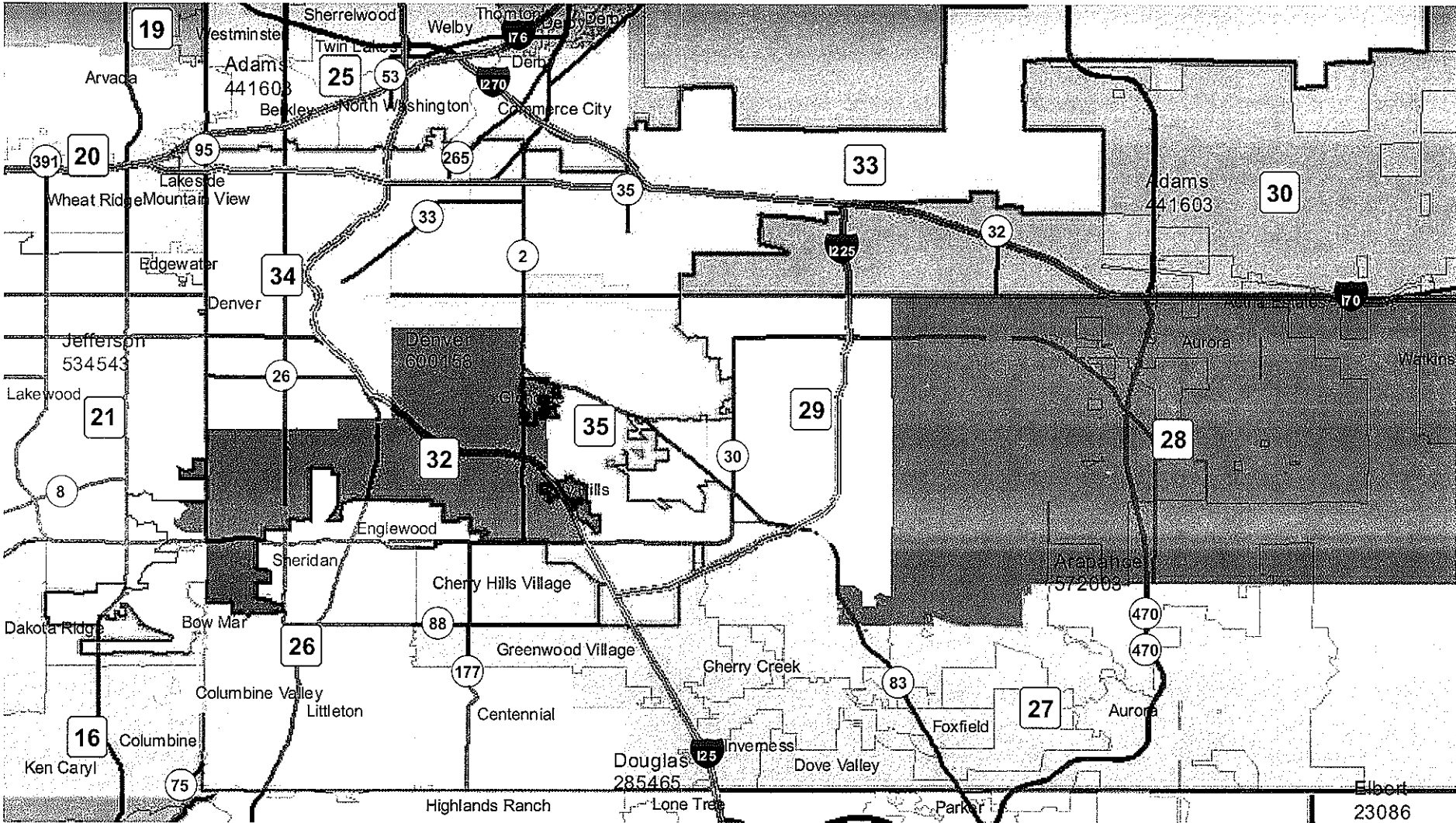

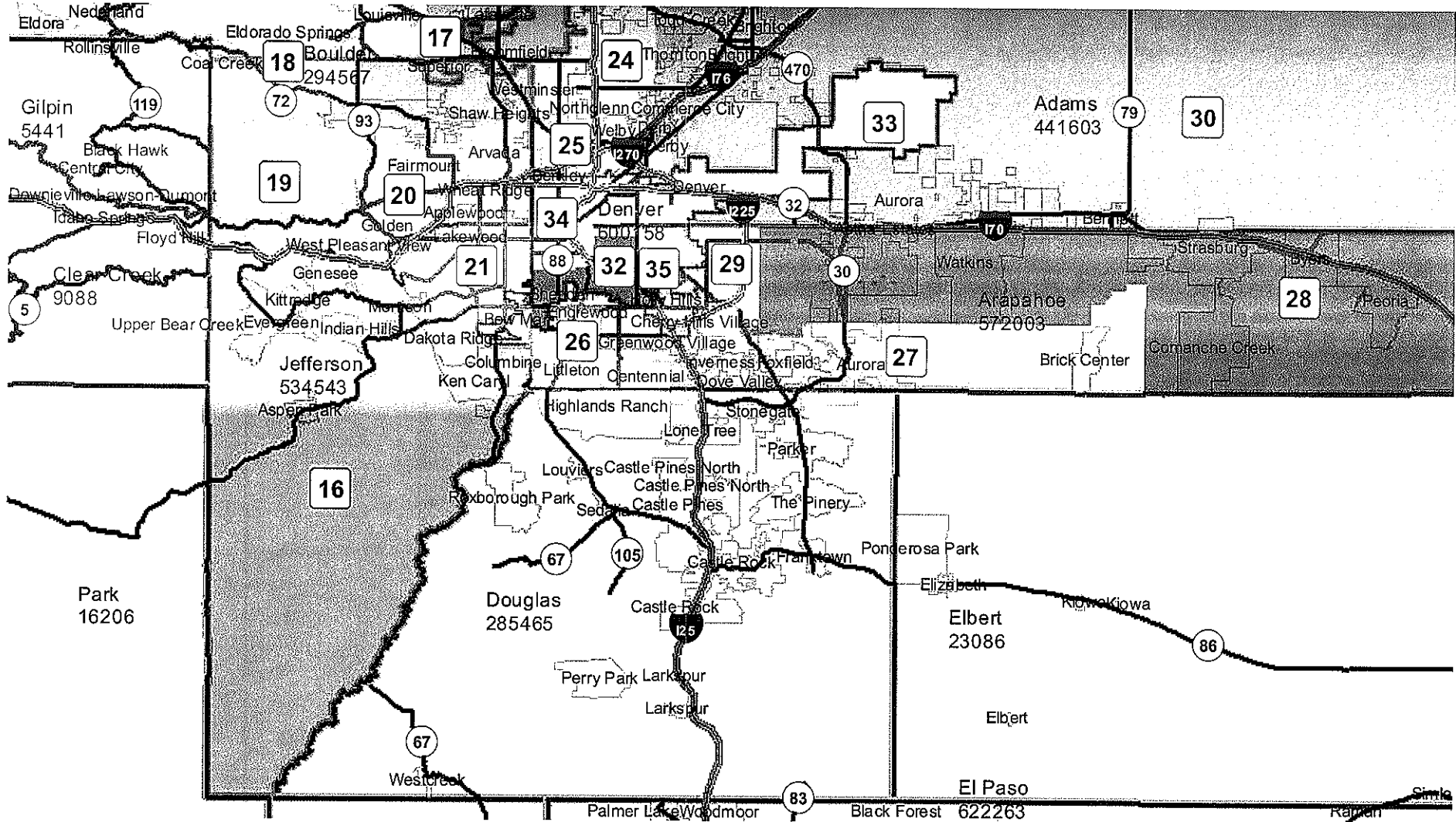
